Sheri Leegwater: is entering her 5th year as the Head Coach of the Nyack Warriors Volleyball team. She brings 20 years of experience as a player and a coach at the club amateur and collegiate levels.

She started playing volleyball when she was 13 years old and continues to play in USA Volleyball tournaments as well as in several leagues and grass doubles tournaments throughout the tri-state region. Originally from Ridgewood, New Jersey, Leegwater began her playing career as a setter and opposite hitter with Eastern Christian High School in North Haledon, New Jersey, where she lettered 3 years and was captain of the first team in the school's history to bring home a Triple Crown, winning the league, county, and state championships. She then went on to play for Savannah College of Art and Design in Savannah, Georgia as a setter and opposite hitter while studying Historic Preservation and Interior Design. In 2000, Leegwater started coaching at the club level with USA Volleyball and in private instruction.

Leegwater joined the Warriors as Head Coach for the 2004 season. She has been working to build a program that draws from consistent recruiting, solid defense, and a team that demonstrates the highest values of sportsmanship. For all three seasons Leegwater has been at the helm, the Warriors have been the recipient of the CACC Sportsmanship Award.

9:00am: Skill Development

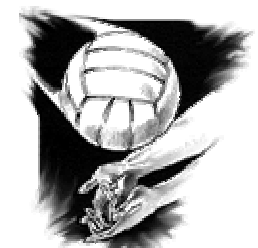
10:00am: Tactical Training
