 - Christian Experience Statement, including a description indicating three years of Ministry experience after completion of a first graduate degree: MDiv or equivalent
 - A formal paper exploring a possible final doctoral project
 - Signed Statement of Faith/Standard of Conduct
 - Church or Organization Reference Form
 - Letter of Academic Reference
 - Official Baccalaureate and Graduate Transcripts, indicating a GPA of at least 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) for the graduate degree
 - Immunization Records

In addition, you must fulfill the following requirements:
- TOEFL score: 213 CBT or 78 IBT or 550 WBT School Code: 2560
 - International Baccalaureate and Graduate Transcripts submitted to World Education Services
 - Visa and Passport copies of you and any family members moving with you in case you plan to reside in the USA for the duration of your course of studies.
 - Affidavit of Support for residential students
