

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Self-Support Affidavit of Monetary Support Instructions

Your Commitment as someone submitting an Affidavit of Monetary Support:

When you complete the above Self-Sponsoring Affidavit of Monetary Support, you are certifying and swearing to Nyack College/ Seminary, a public official, and the U.S. government that you can and will provide the specific amount pledged for the entire length of the academic program. *For example*, a two-year program requires you have the annual amount pledged for the two years.

Work on-campus is not guaranteed and therefore cannot be included in the initial covering of the academic budget.

If you do not have sufficient funds to cover the balance of the total estimated budget for the entire program, it is recommended that you generate further support and document it using the other available Affidavits of Monetary Support for your program. Insufficient monetary support and documentation will prohibit Nyack College/ATS from issuing the Form I-20.

Instructions for Completing the Affidavit:

1. Indicate the amount of financial resources you intend to commit to the cost of studies.
2. Sign the affidavit *in the presence of* a notary public or other legal certifying witness.
The notary public or official must sign the official seal on the affidavit.
3. Attach official documents/bank statements that show your ability to cover the stated financial commitment.
4. Financial documents must be in English, less than three months old and stated in U.S. dollars. Photocopies and faxes are accepted. The student will need the originals when applying for his/her F-1 visa.

Documenting Financial Support:

Document your ability to cover the stated pledge by sending the following documents:

1. An account statement from a bank or other financial institution stating the amount on deposit and current date. All statements must indicate U.S. dollar amounts. Bank forms should be on Bank letterhead and accompanied with official bank signature.
2. The name(s) on the bank statement must match the name(s) on affidavit(s) of support.

DO NOT SEND:

1. Property value statements.
2. Retirement account information.
3. Bank statements or tax returns that are not in sponsor's name.
