POLICIES REGARDING DIRECTED STUDIES

A Directed Study is an independent course of guided research designed by a student and faculty member.

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS: Interested students must have completed at least 12 credits of study at ATS with a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 and have prior approval of the Registrar and the Dean of the Seminary. No more than 20% of a degree program may be fulfilled through courses taken independently (combination of ISP courses & directed studies). Candidates for the Master of Arts may request to exceed this limit if their program requires special research. The requests must be submitted in writing to the Registrar's Office and must be approved by the Academic Dean.

Every graduate credit of guided or independent study must demonstrate that the student has done at least 50 hours of work; therefore, a 3 credit guided or independent study requires 150 hours of work.

CALENDAR REQUIREMENTS: All assignments must be completed within the normal semester schedule.

FEES: In addition to regular tuition & fees, students must pay an academic course fee of \$100/credit. This amount will be charged directly to the student's account. Students receiving "tuition remission" as an employee or spouse/dependent of an employee are not permitted to use this benefit towards a directed study course.
