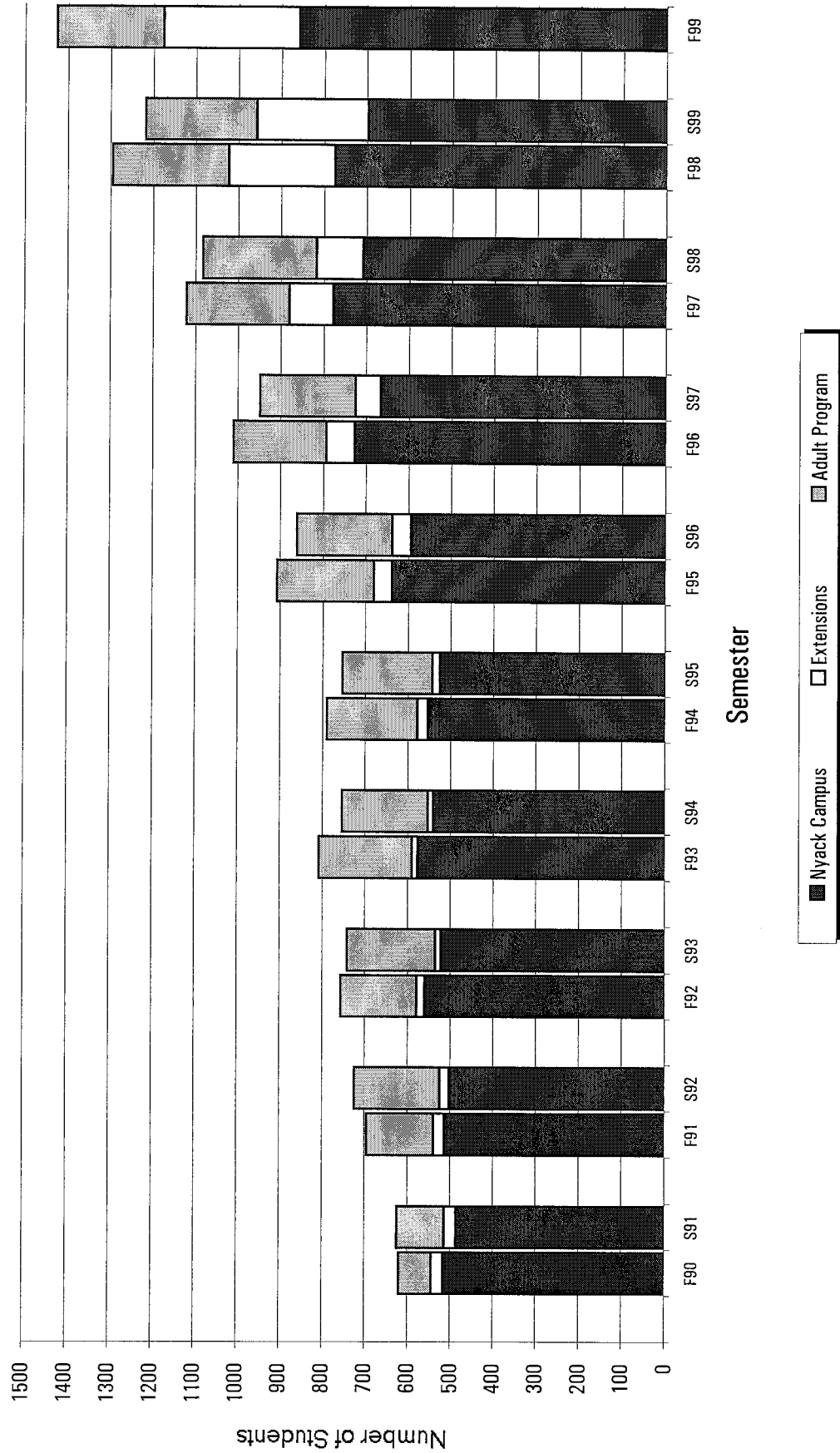

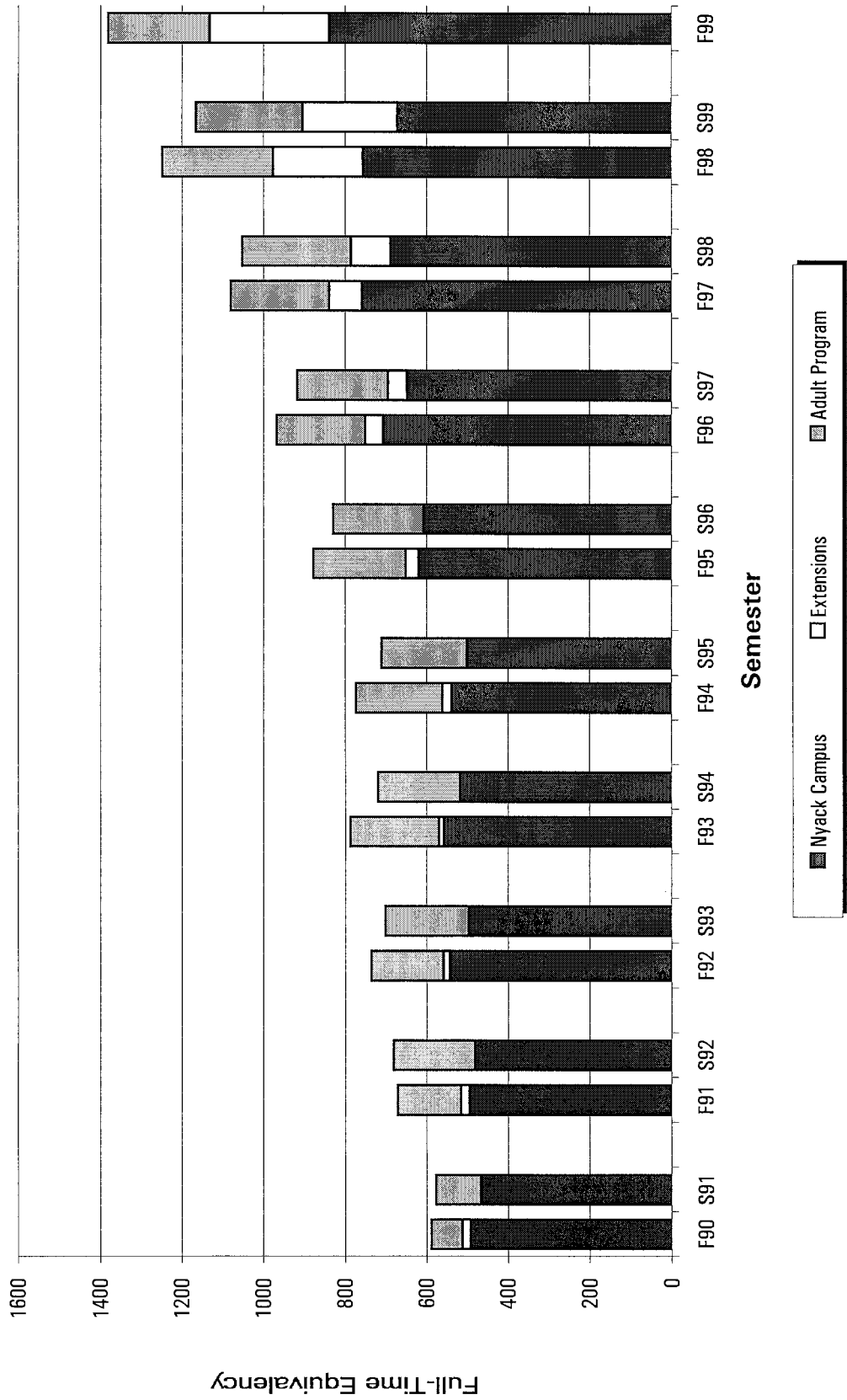

All Campuses, All Programs**

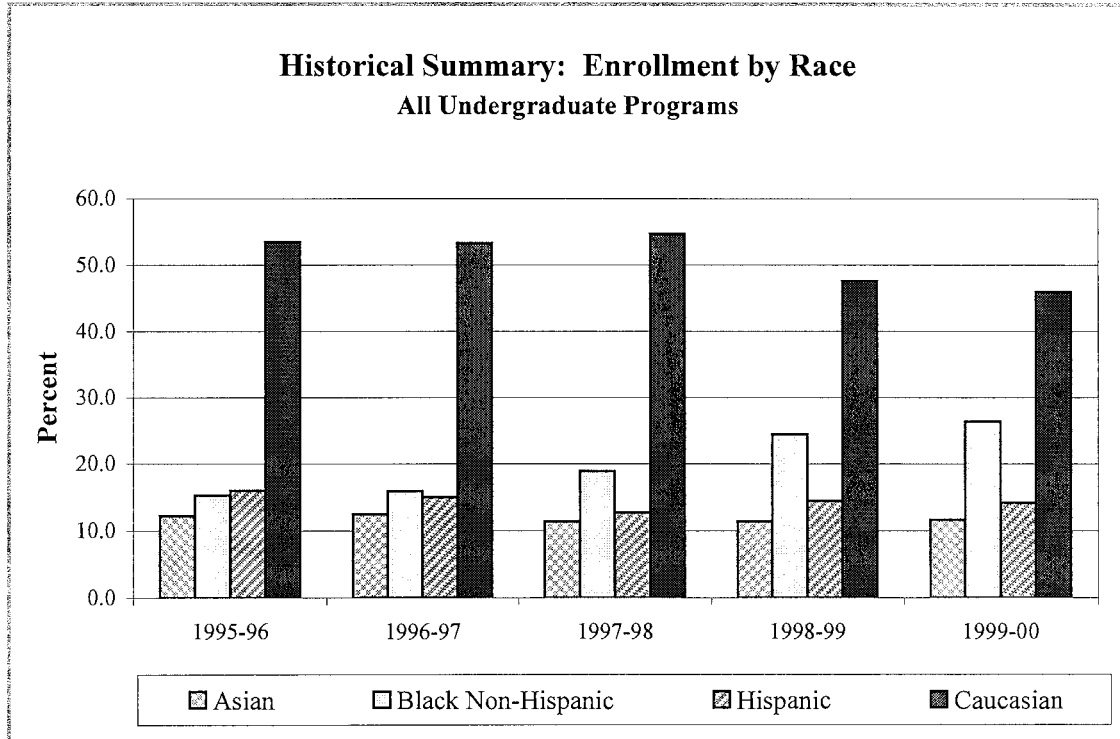

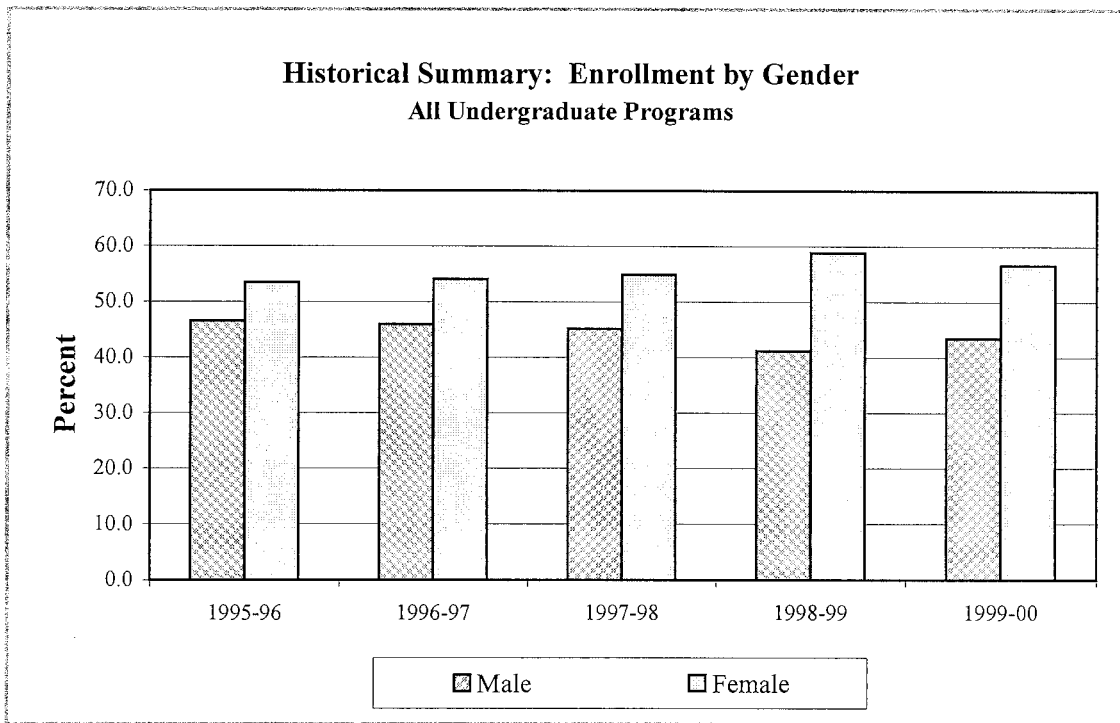

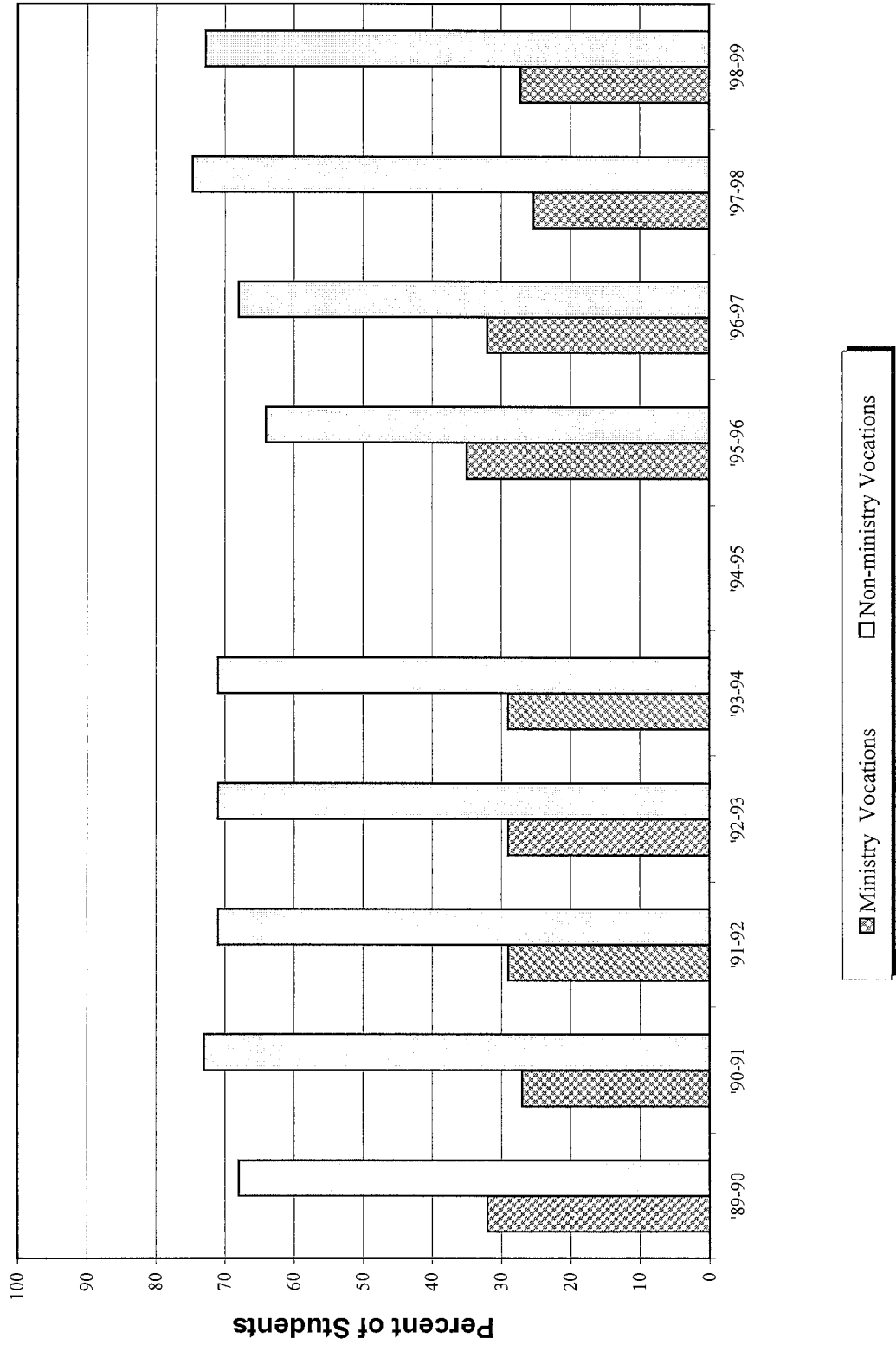
