The Office of Institutional Research has in its archives Nyack College *Factbooks* dating back to 1987. Over the years, these publications have proven to be an invaluable source of information for administrators, faculty, students and staff in their research and decision-making activities.

This year marks several dramatic changes in the preparation of the *Factbook*. Most noticeable is the expansion of the publication to provide information for the entire institution of Nyack College, including all undergraduate and Alliance Theological Seminary* programs. Data for ATS is provided in a special supplement that can stand alone as a separate publication in order to meet the unique needs of the seminary for its own independent *Factbook*.

The *Factbook* design has been re-configured to facilitate its conversion to electronic form for publication on an Institutional Research web-page, now under construction. In addition, this fall an electronic file of enrollment data was warehoused by the Office of Institutional Research in order to facilitate reporting and research at a more detailed level than what has been done in the *Factbook*. Both practices are planned to continue on an annual basis. I hope you will avail yourself of these resources as the need arises.

These changes have been a long time in coming and necessitated by the ever-increasing demands of our information-dependent society. I thank you for your patience in awaiting the *Fall 2001 Factbook* during these days of conversion and “reconstruction” and, as always, welcome your comments or suggestions.

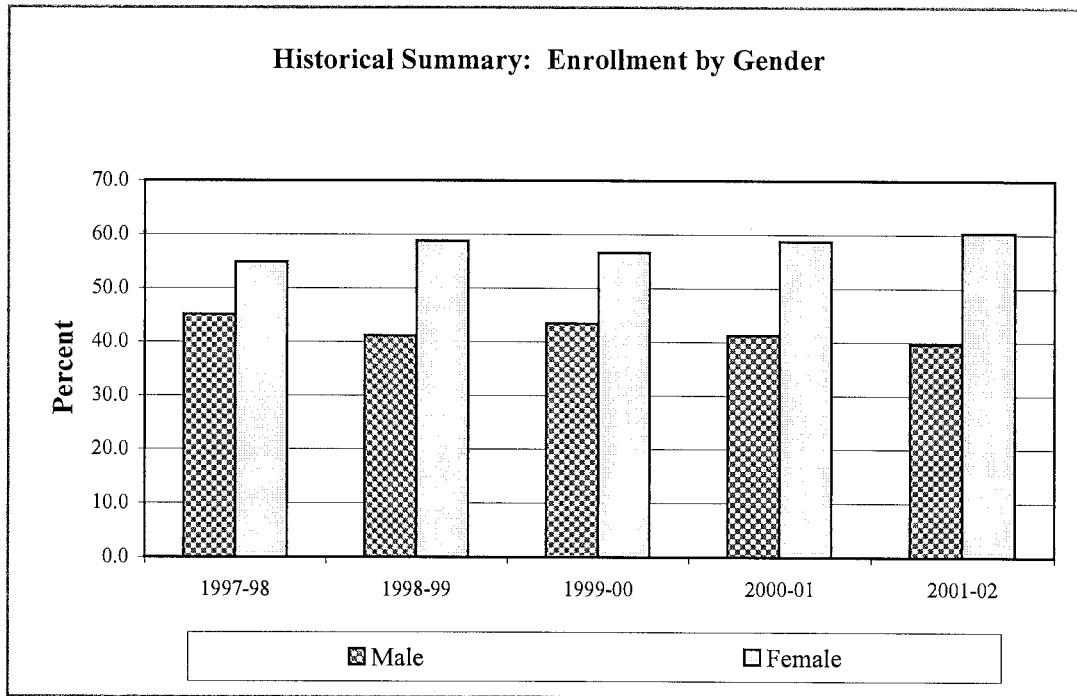


Enrollment by Gender
