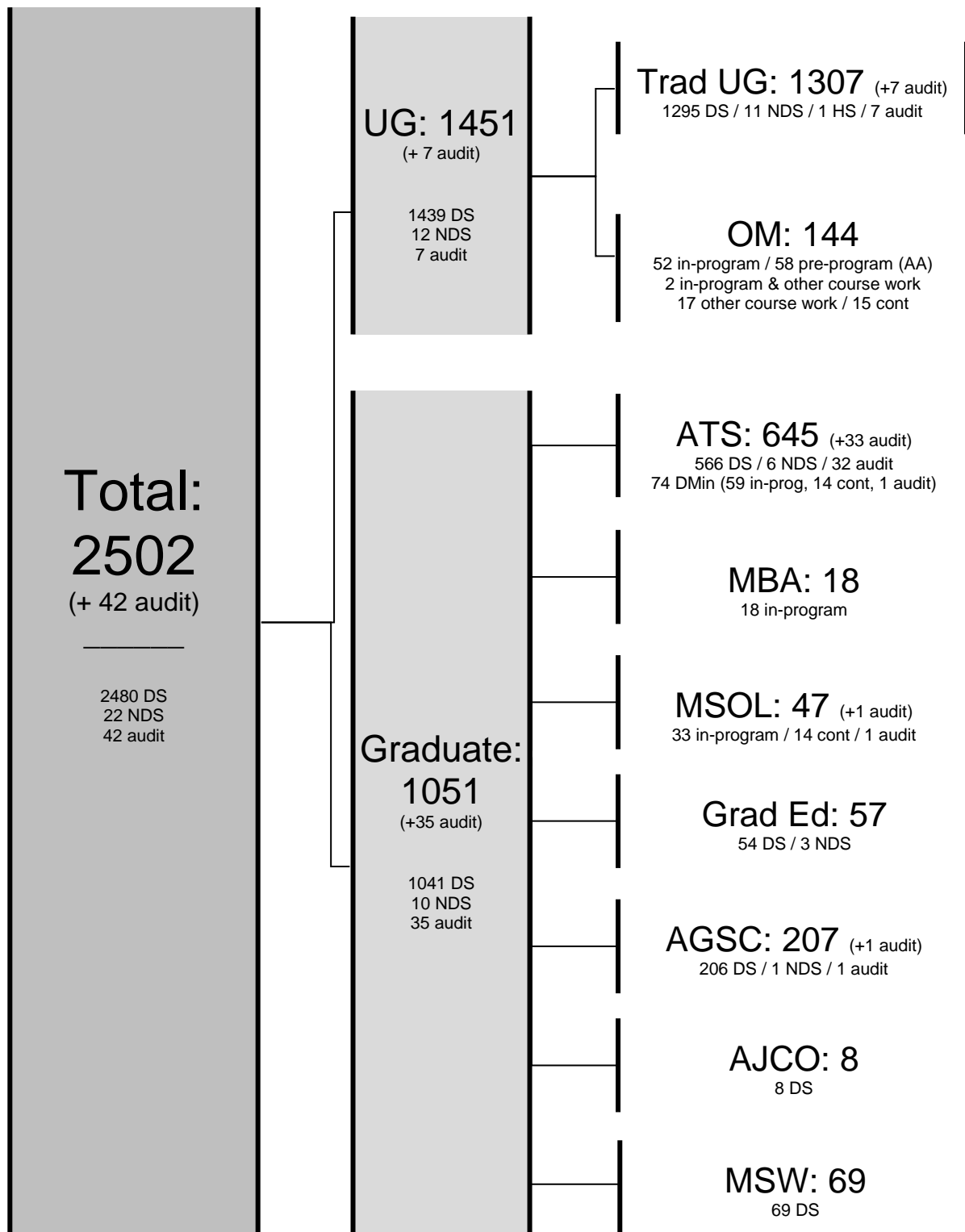

- 1 The "census date" (the date of the data extraction from campus systems) for enrollment and most other reports is on or about October 1 (October 15 prior to 2015).
- 2 Enrollment figures for cohort-based programs reflect active registrations as of the census date
- 3 Students enrolled in two programs (generally matriculated in one and non-matriculated in the other) are counted only once in the program in which they are matriculated. In the case of matriculated enrollment in two programs, enrollment is counted in the higher-level program. A note indicating how many students have been eliminated from each program for this reason is included on the "Total Headcount by Program" page. (Note: none for Fall 2015).

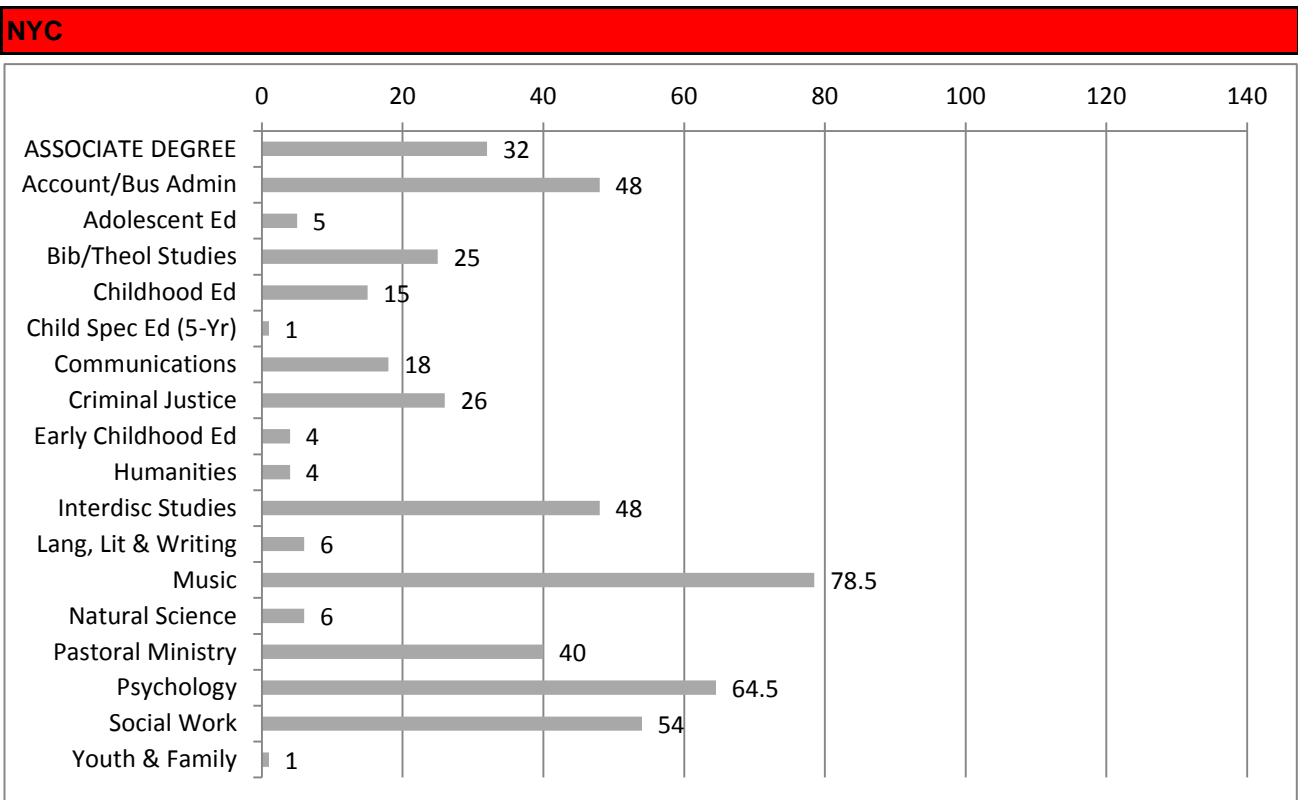
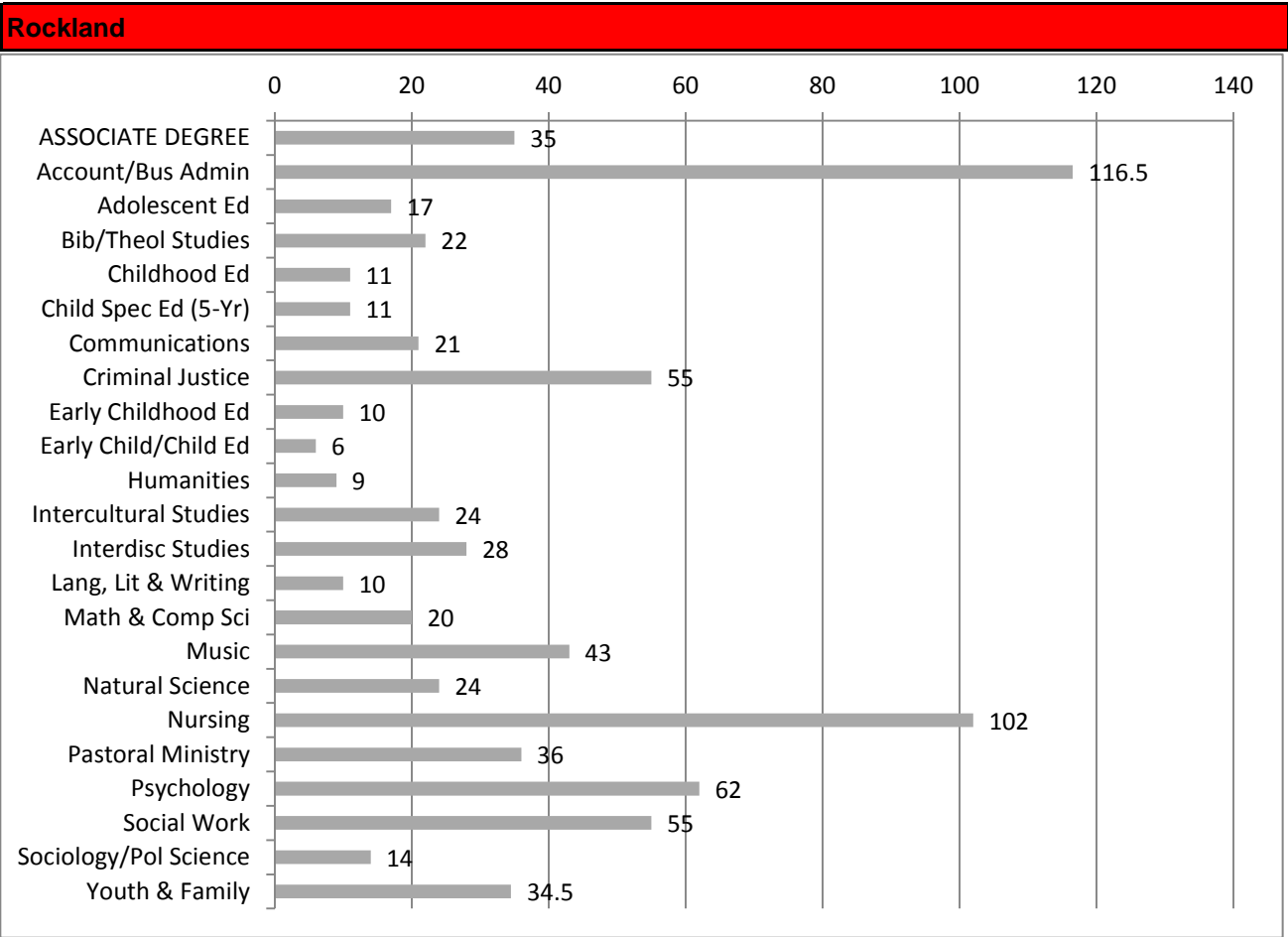

Enrollment by Department (Traditional Undergraduate)

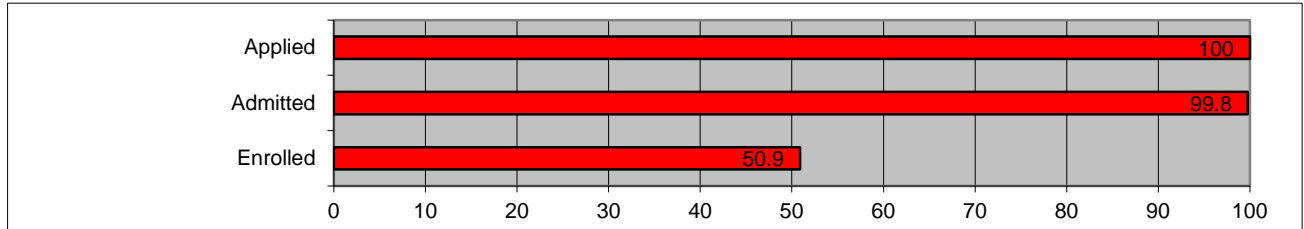

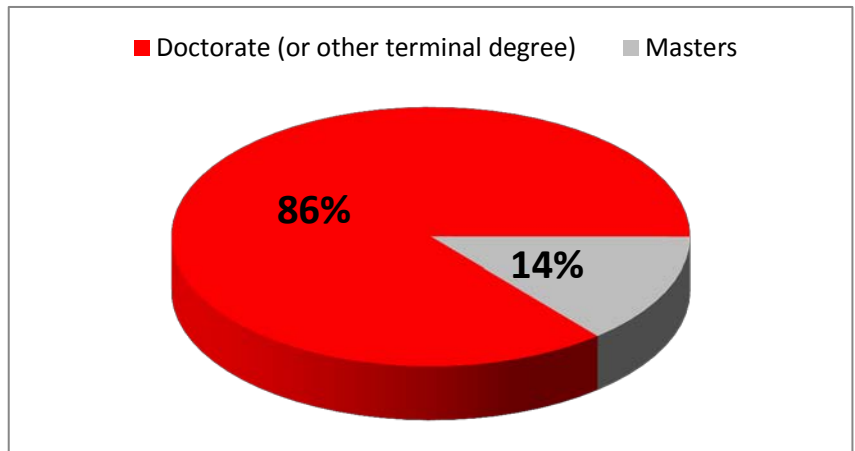
