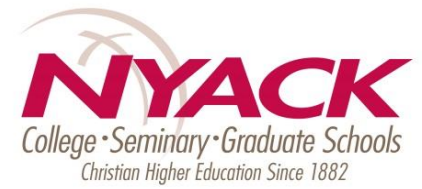

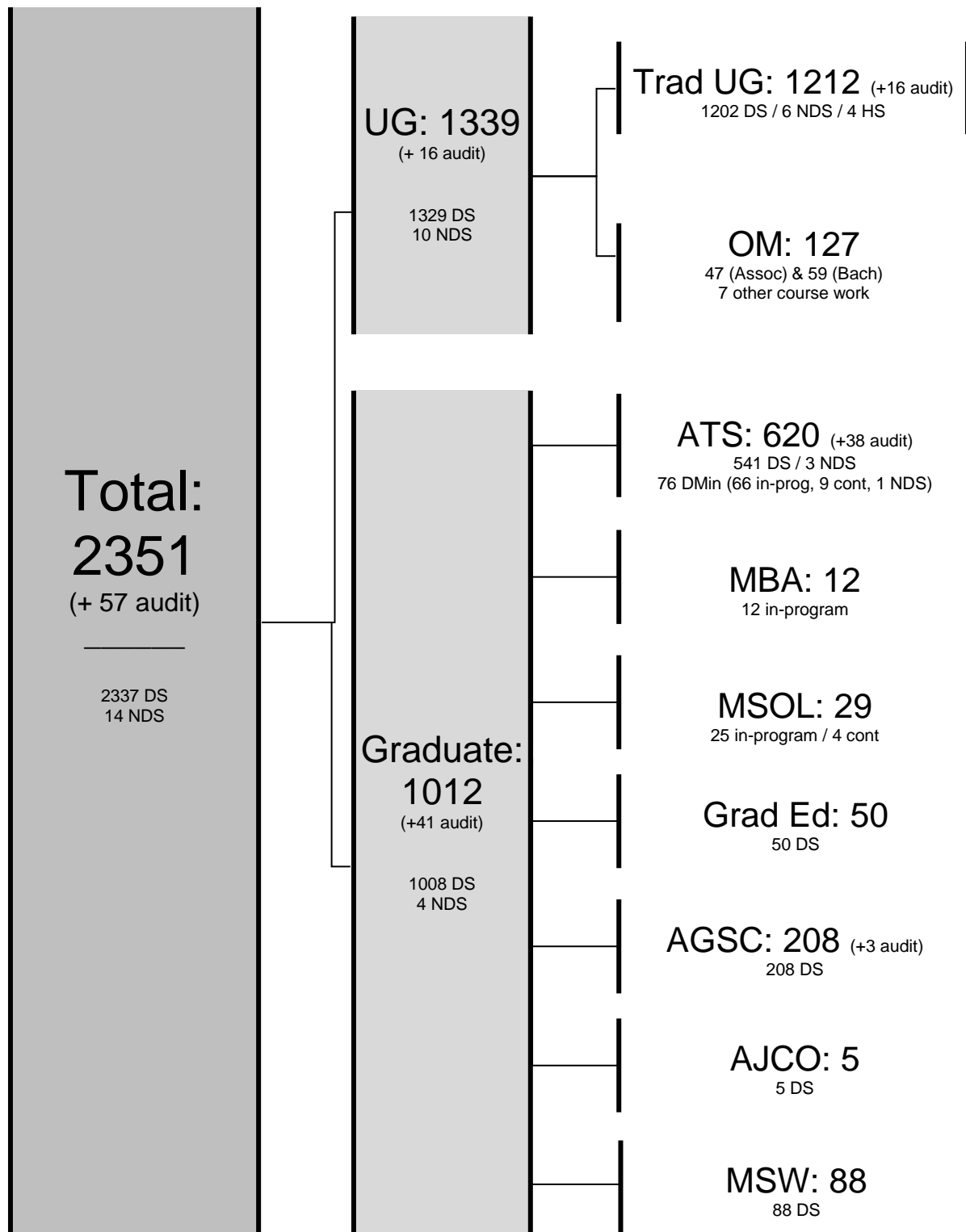

- 1 The "census date" (the date of the data extraction from campus systems) for enrollment and most other reports is on or about October 1 (October 15 prior to 2015).

- 3 Students enrolled in two programs (generally matriculated in one and non-matriculated in the other) are counted only once in the program in which they are matriculated. In the case of matriculated enrollment in two programs, enrollment is counted in the higher-level program.
