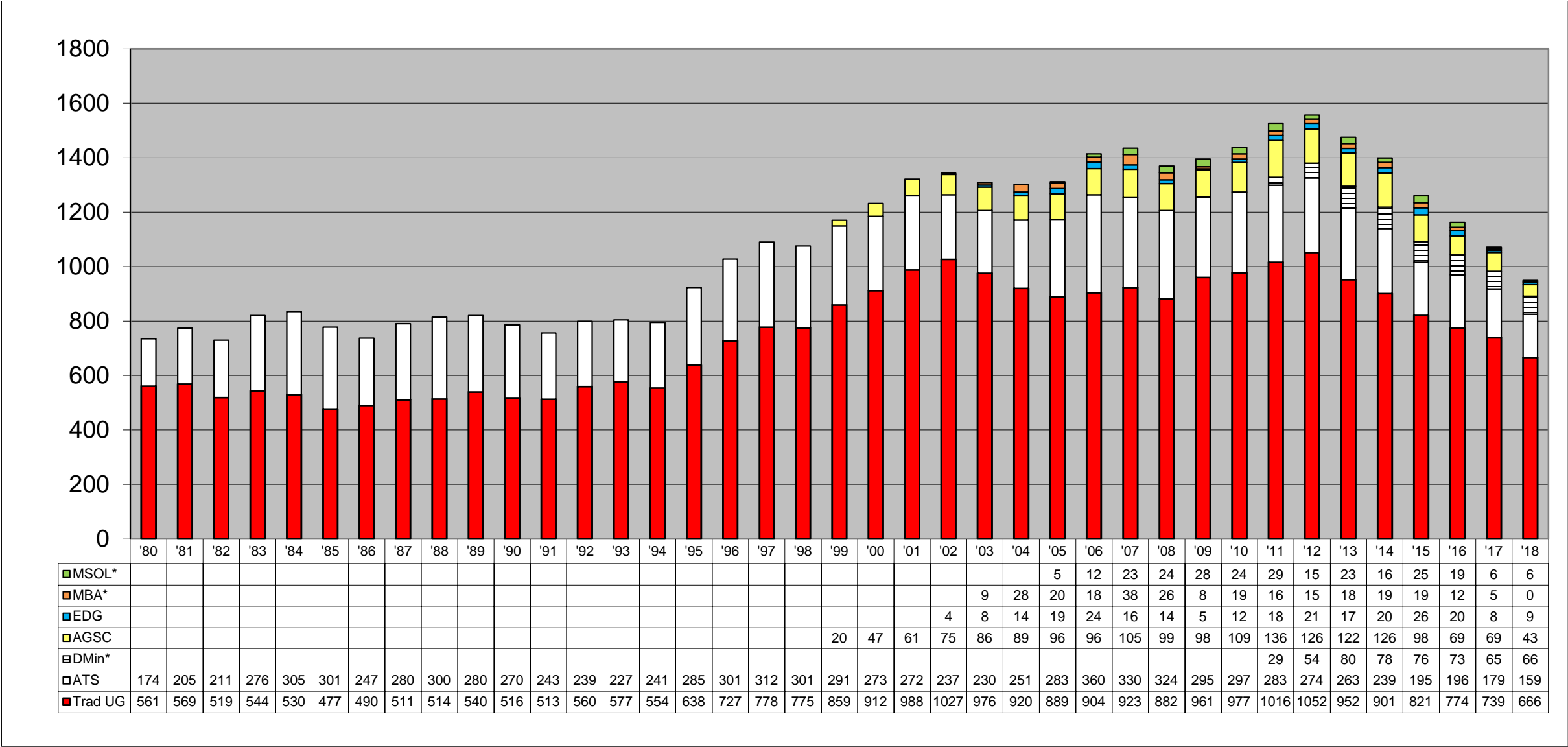

- 2013 Moved to 2 Washington Street



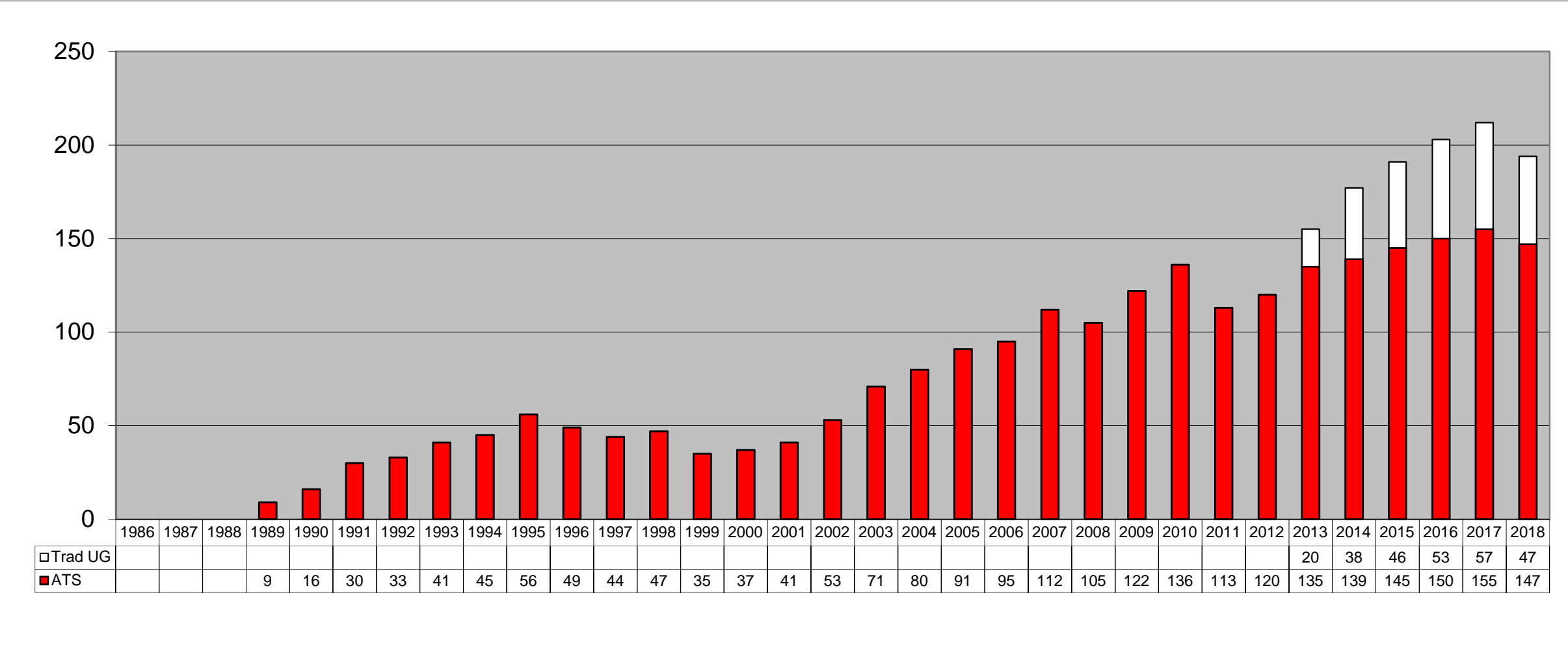

Enrollment by Site

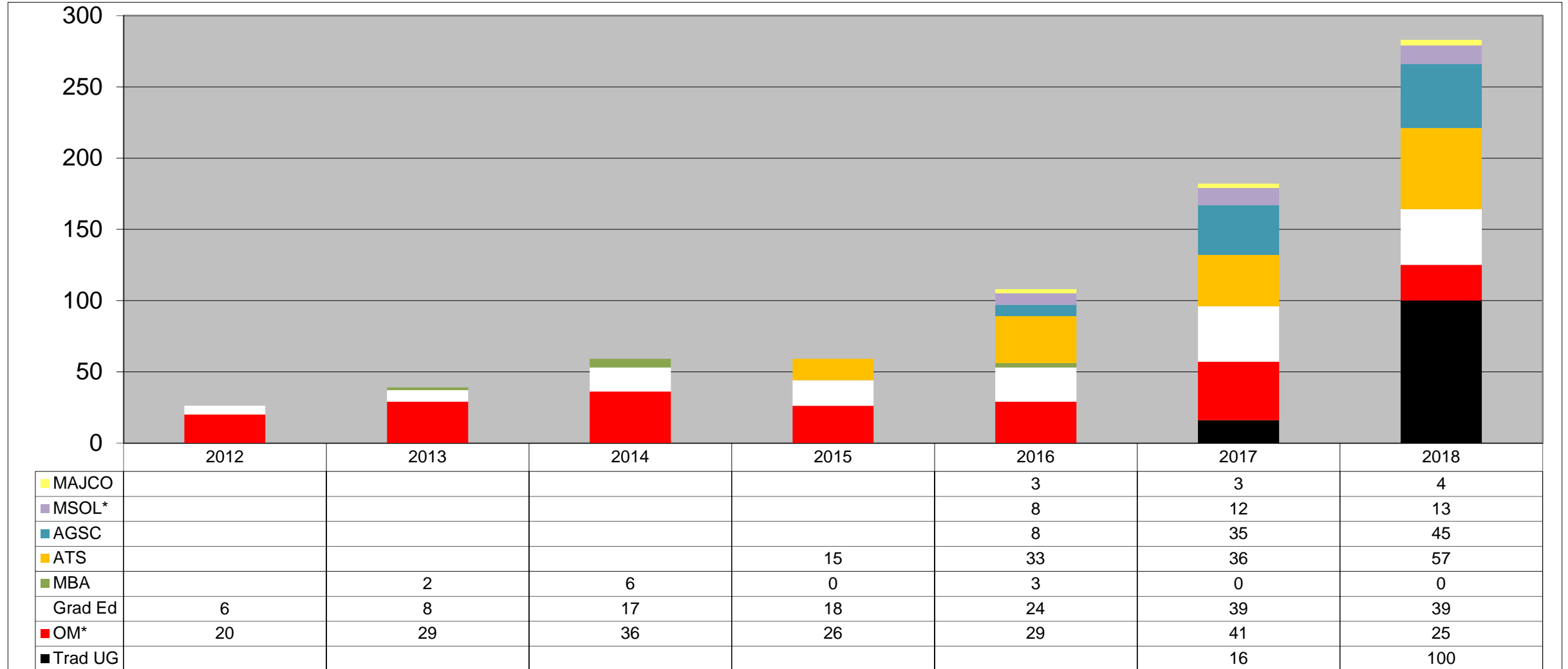

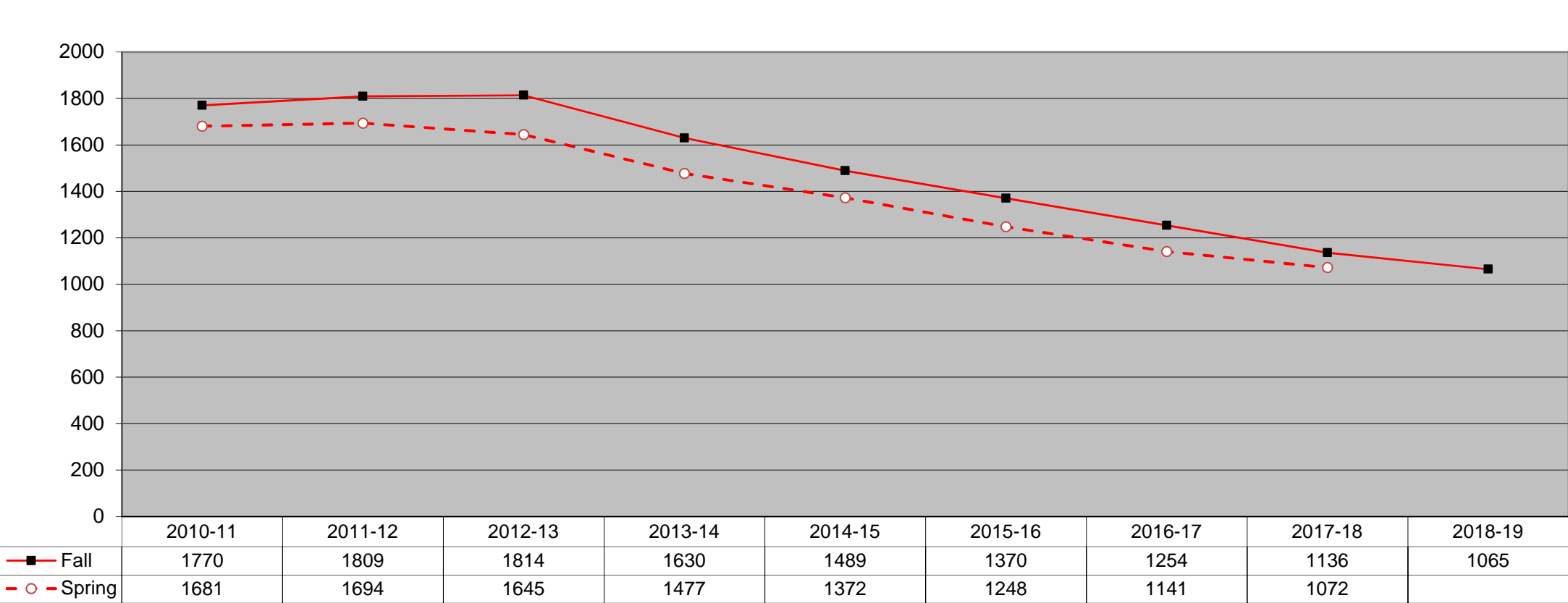

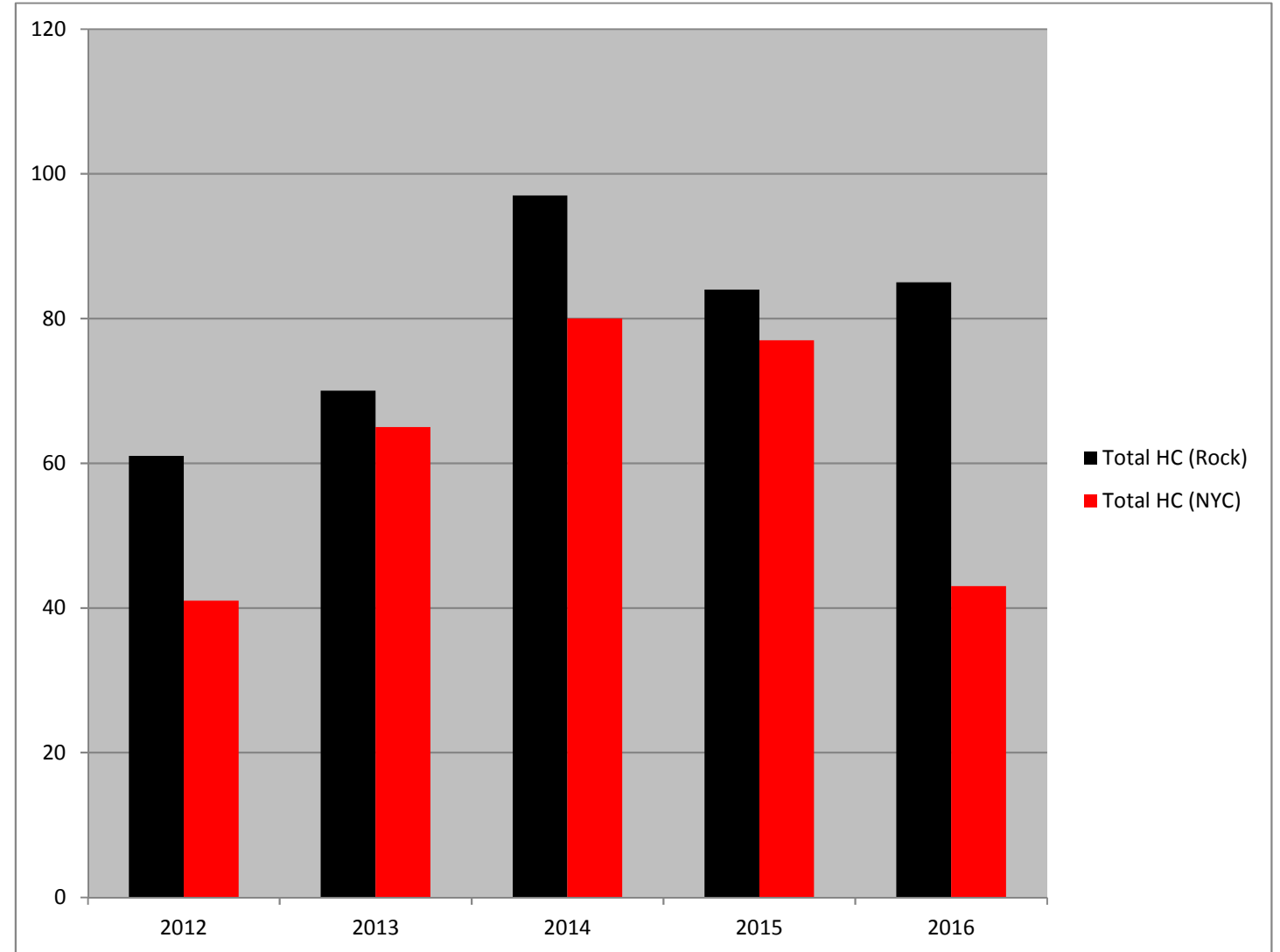

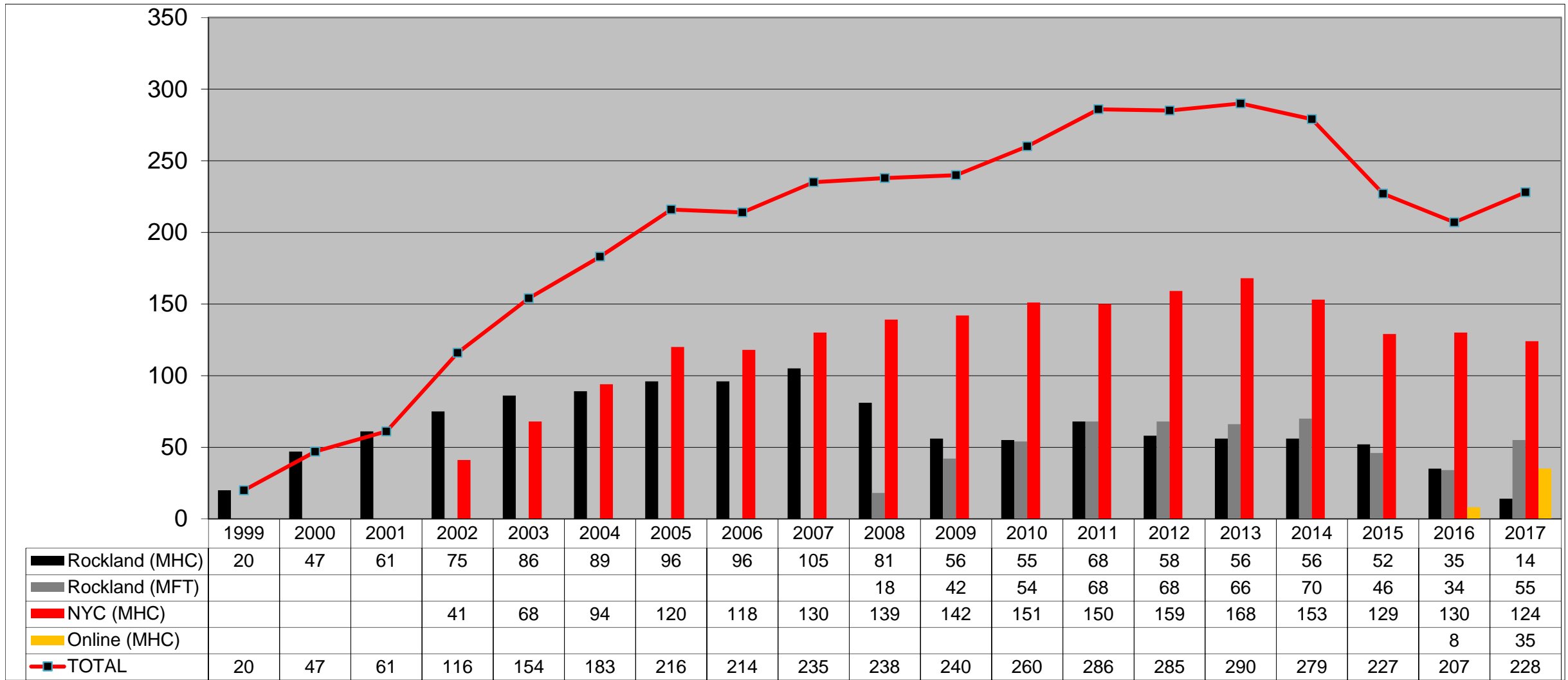

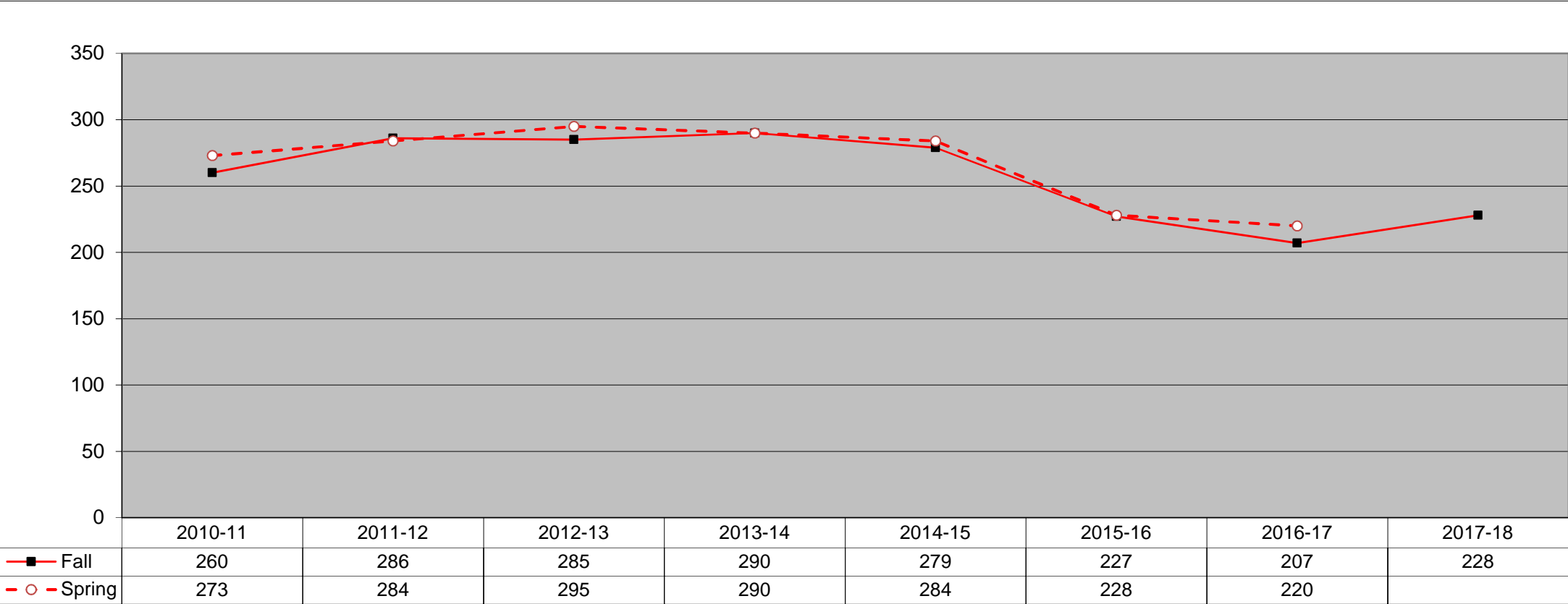

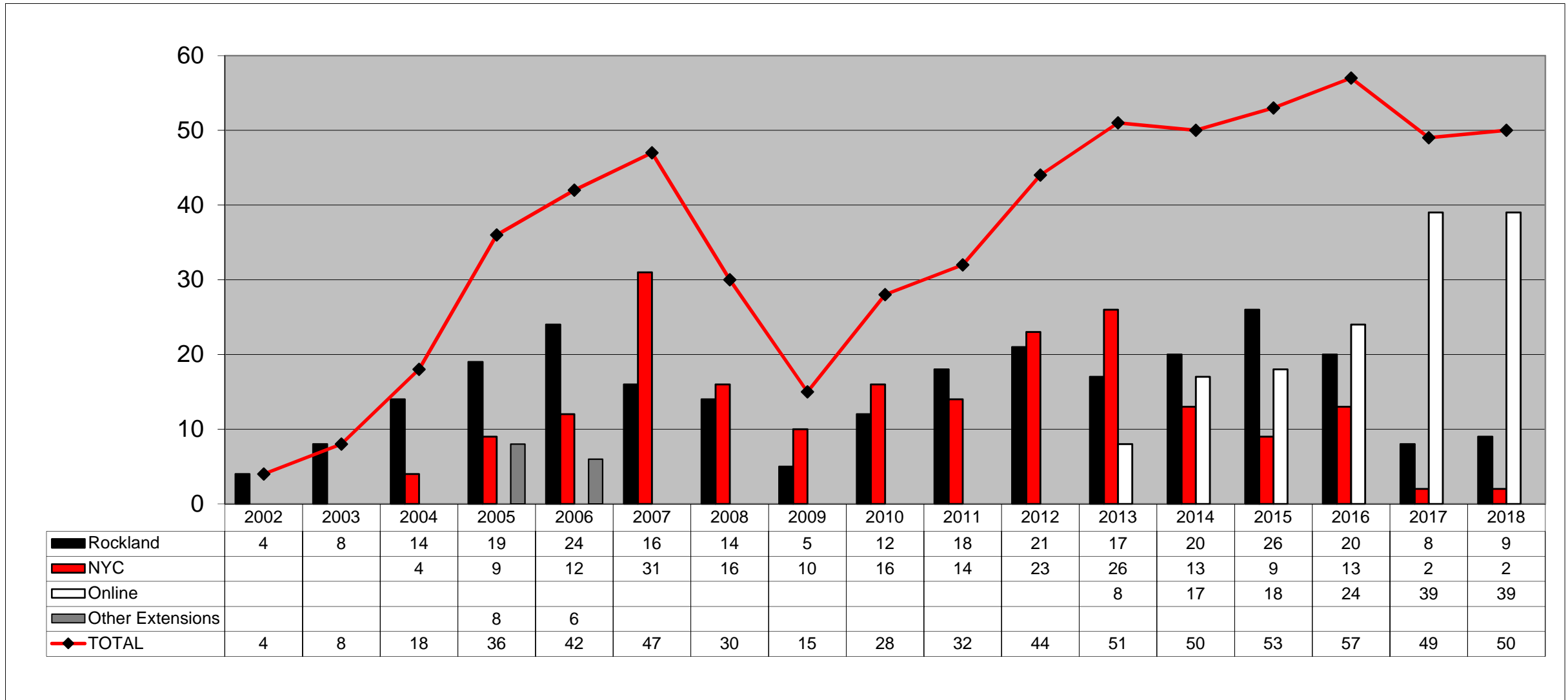


Enrollment by Program

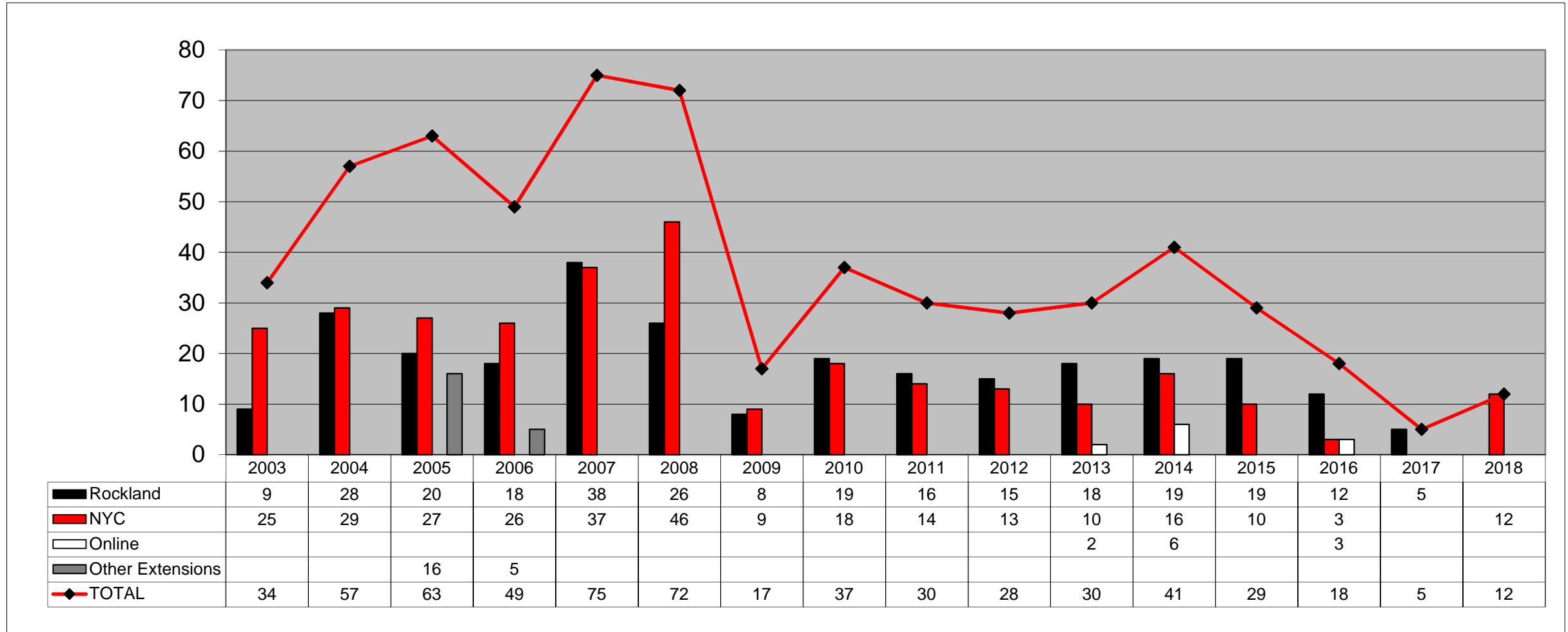

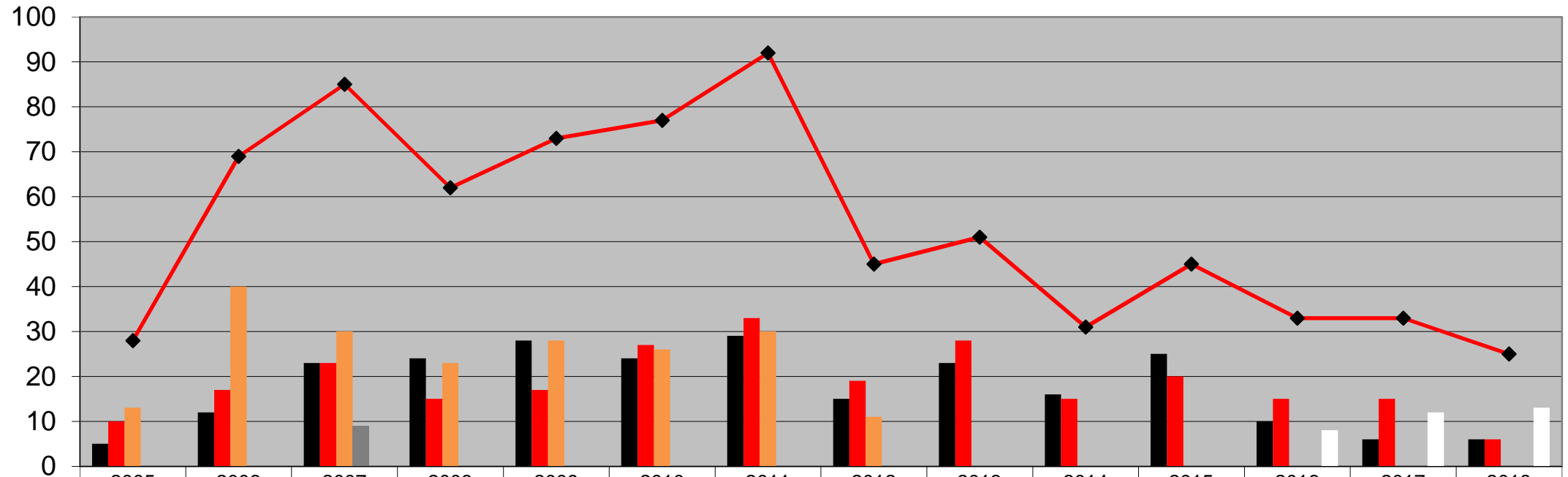

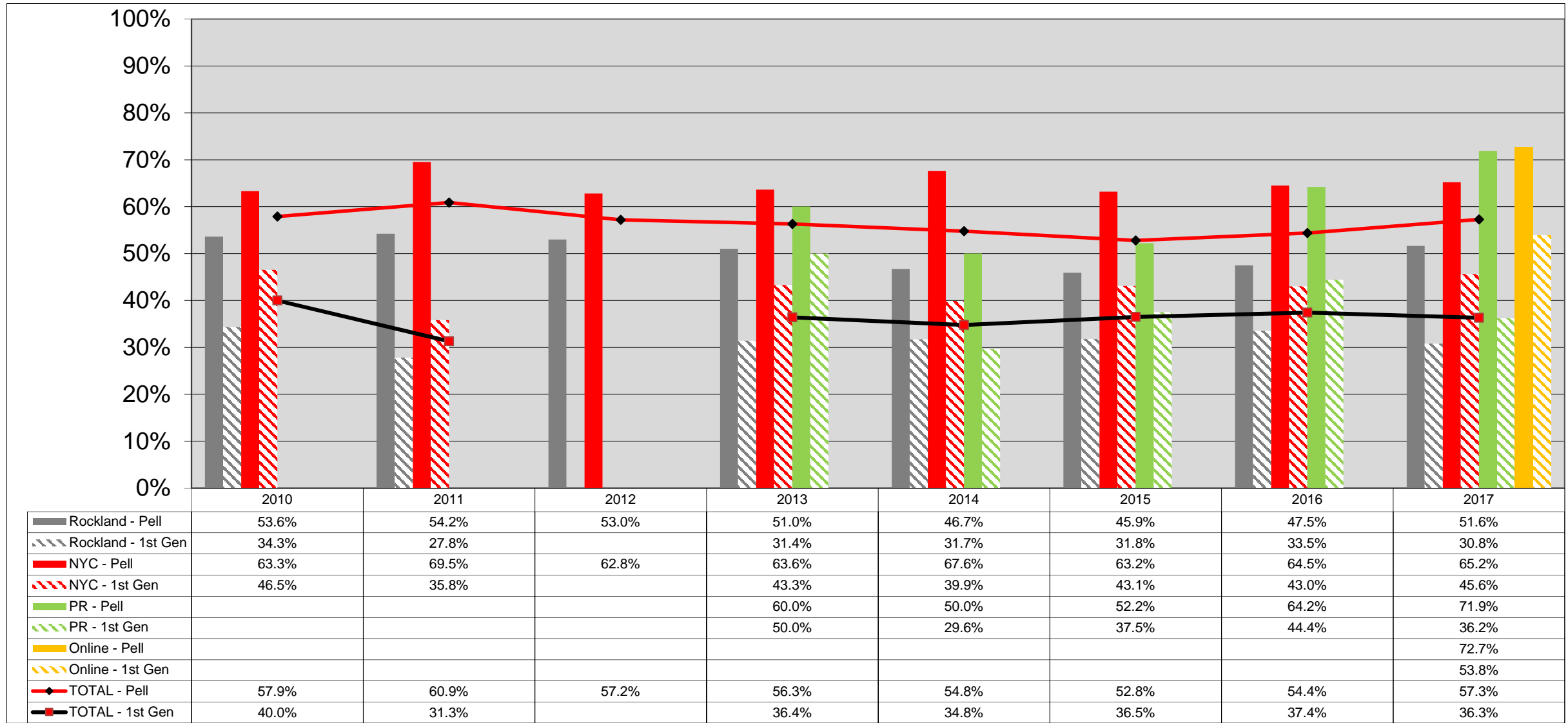

Enrollment by Pell Grant Recipients & 1st Generation Students*

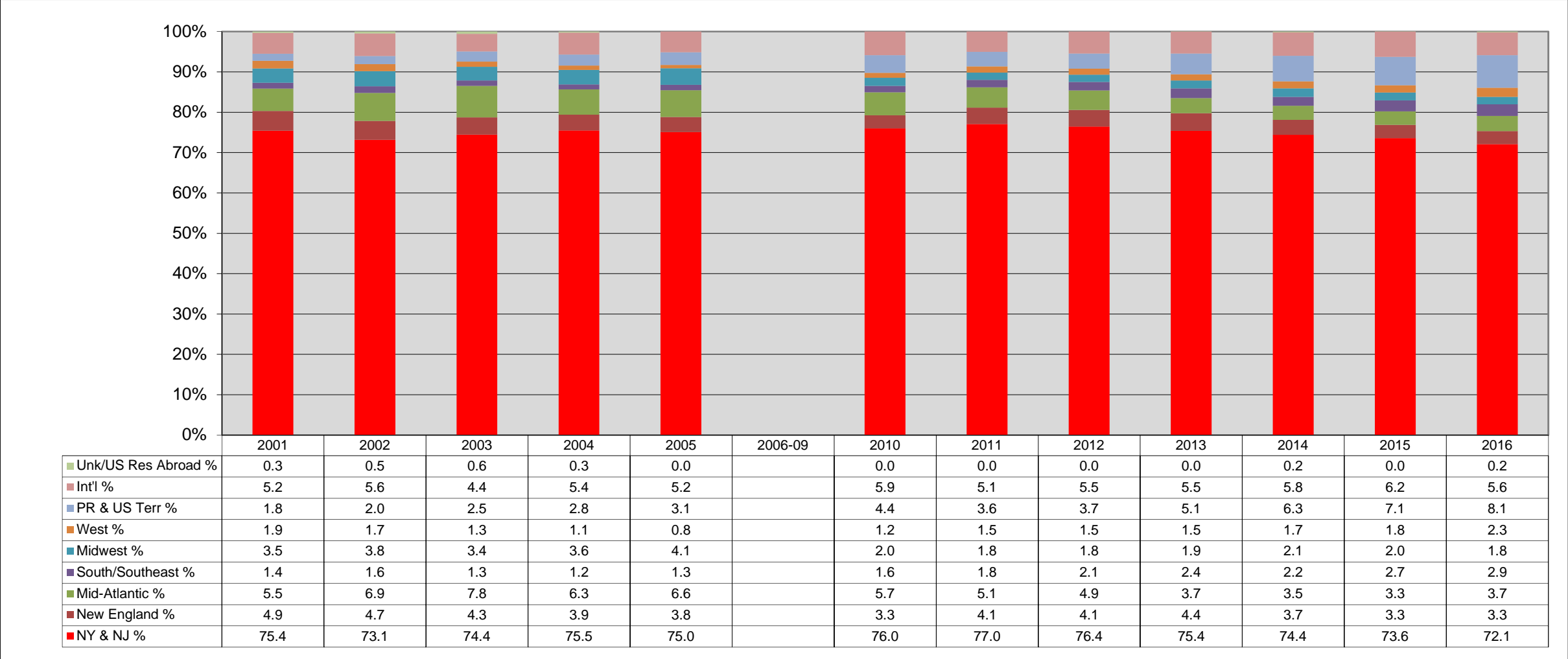

Enrollment by State

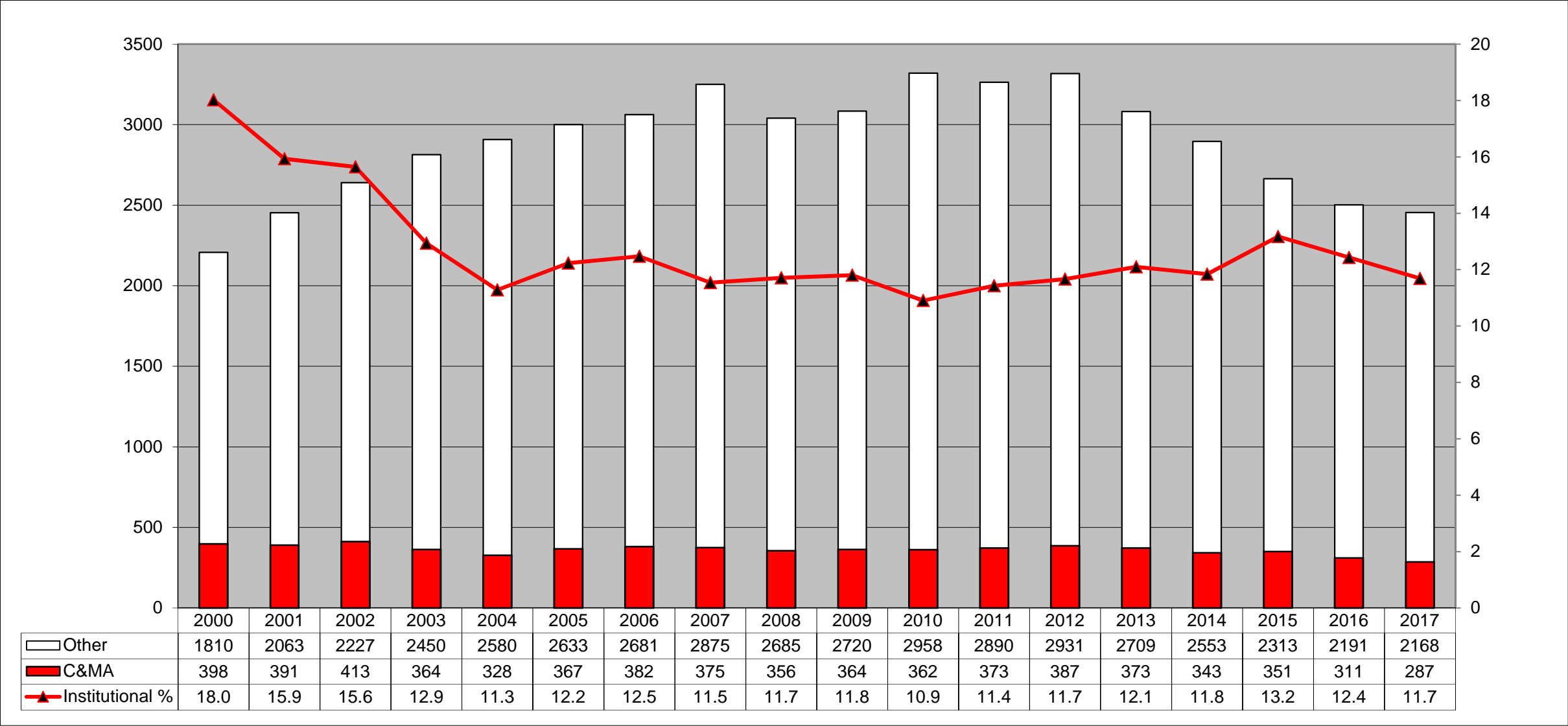

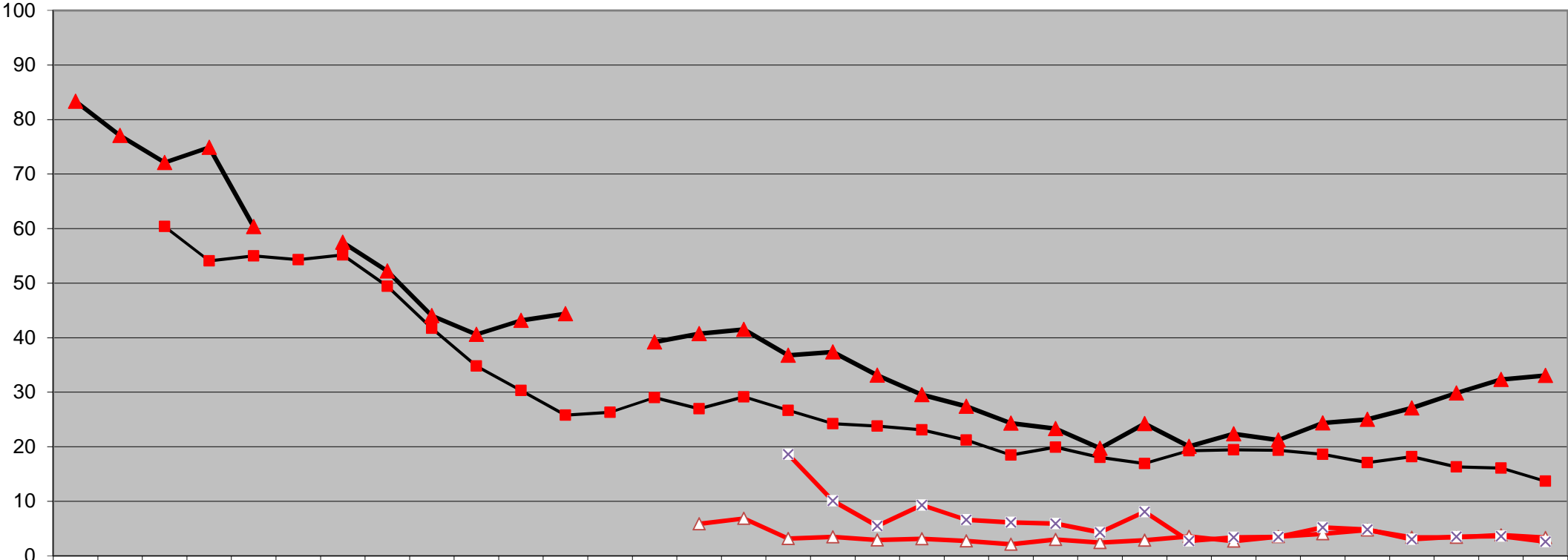

by Program/Site

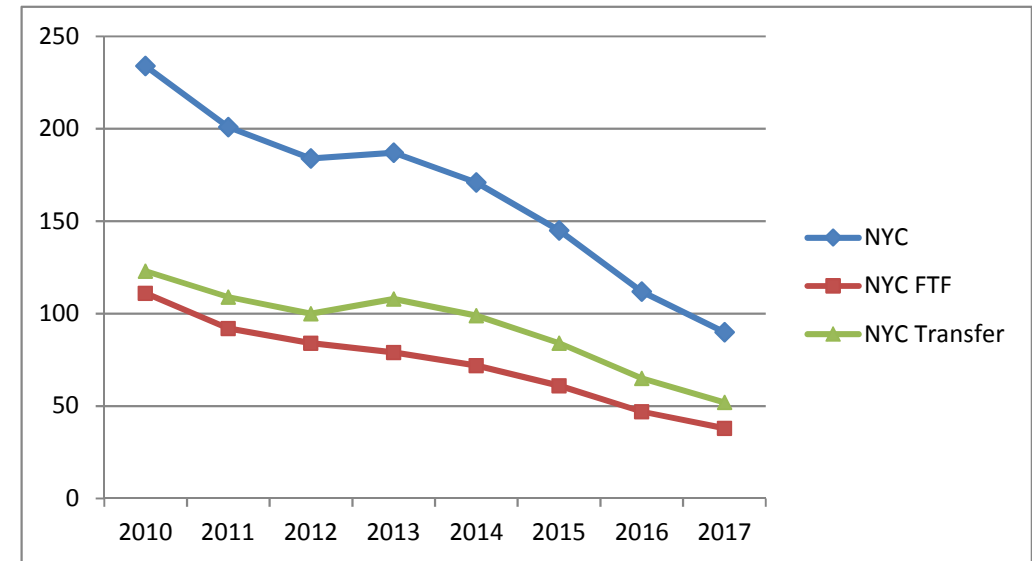
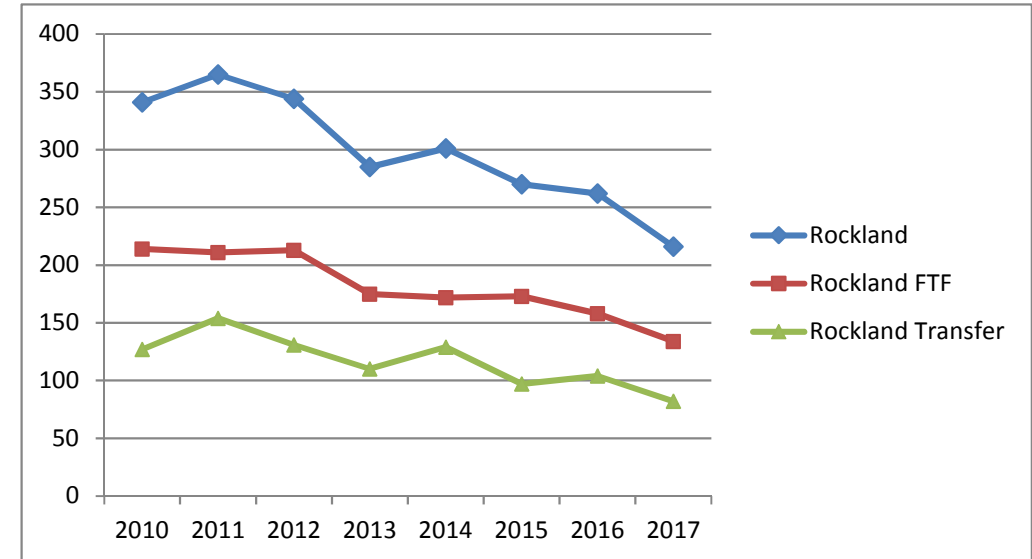
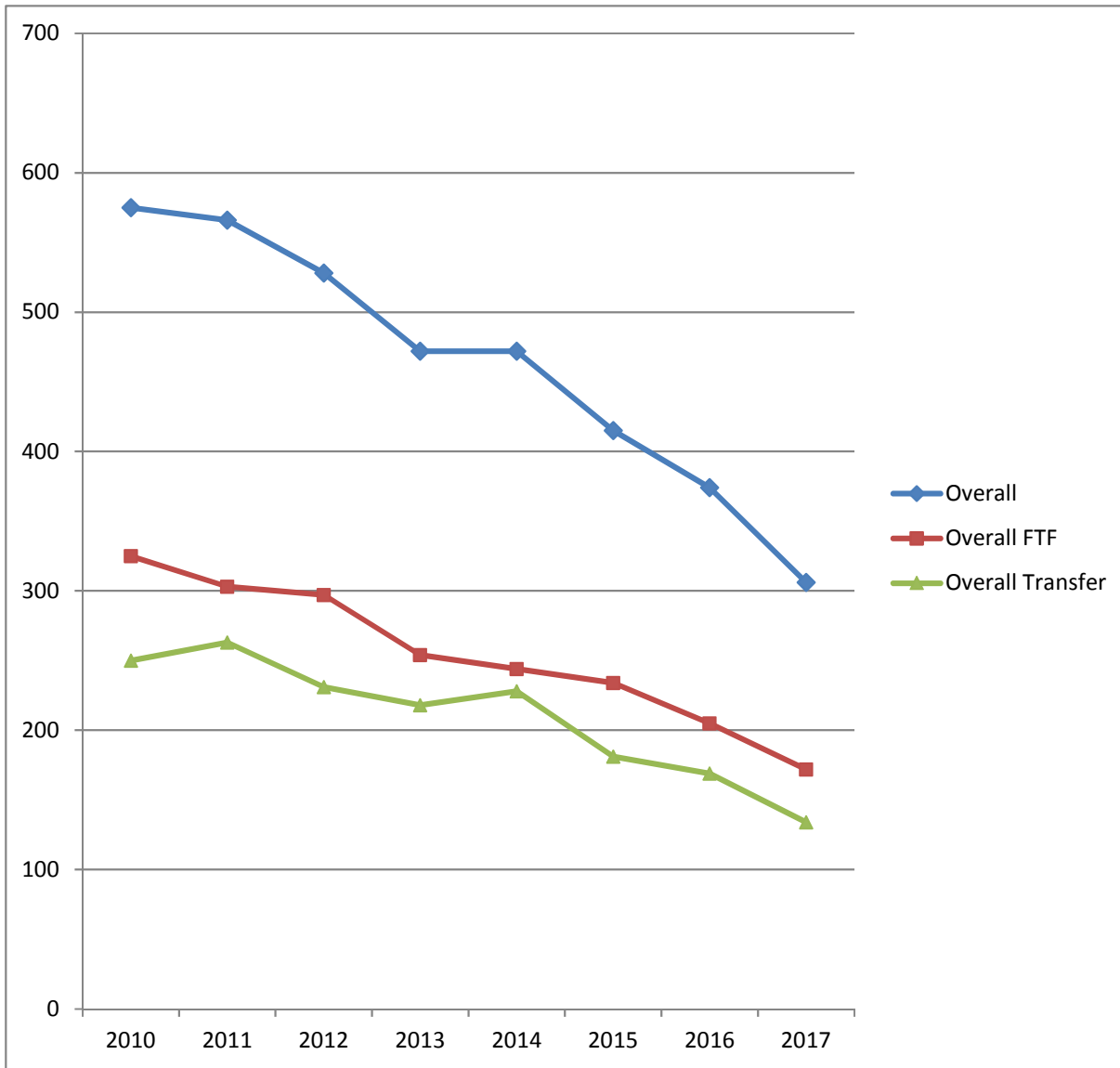

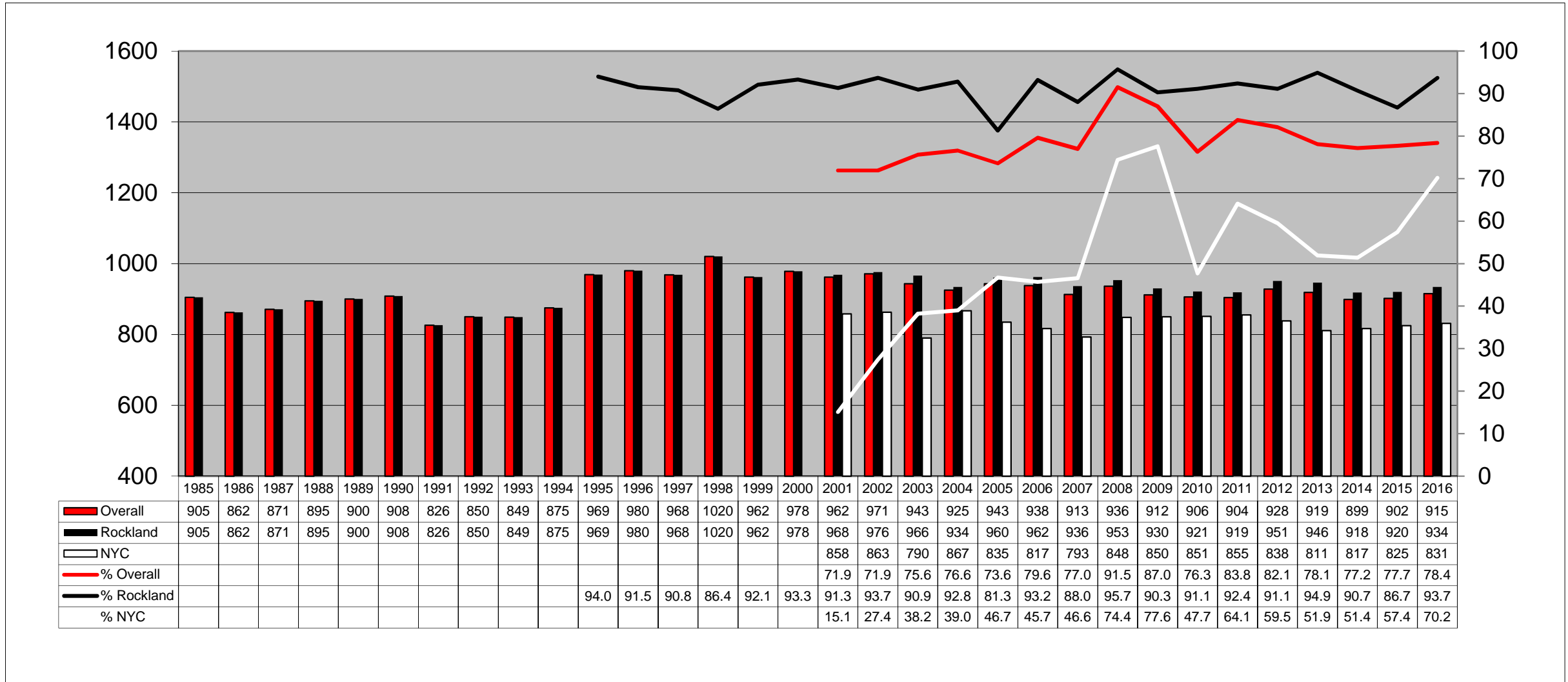
Admissions (Traditional Undergraduate)

Average SAT / ACT Scores & Percent Reporting

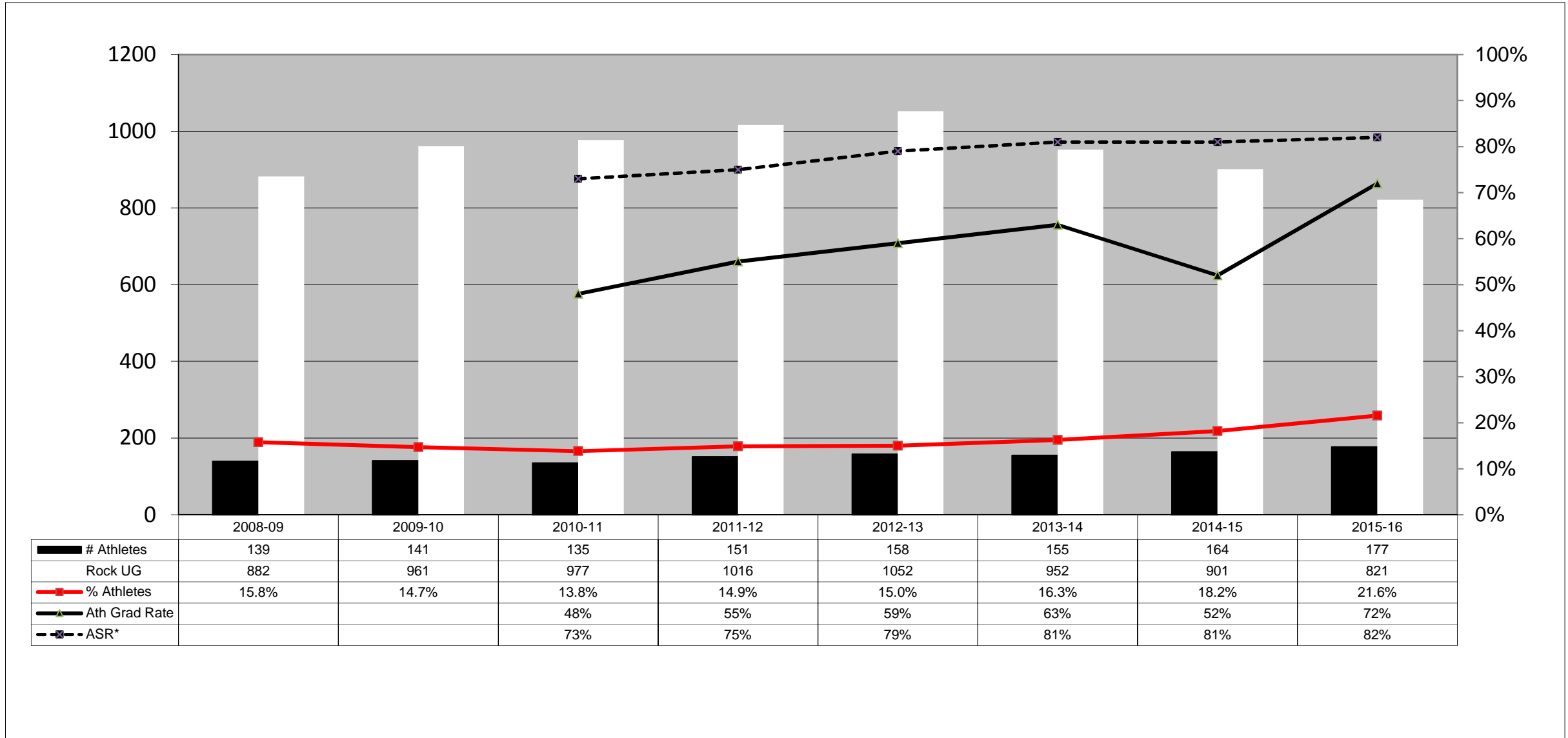
First-time Freshmen (Associate & Bachelor-Seeking)

 Graduation & Academic Success Rates

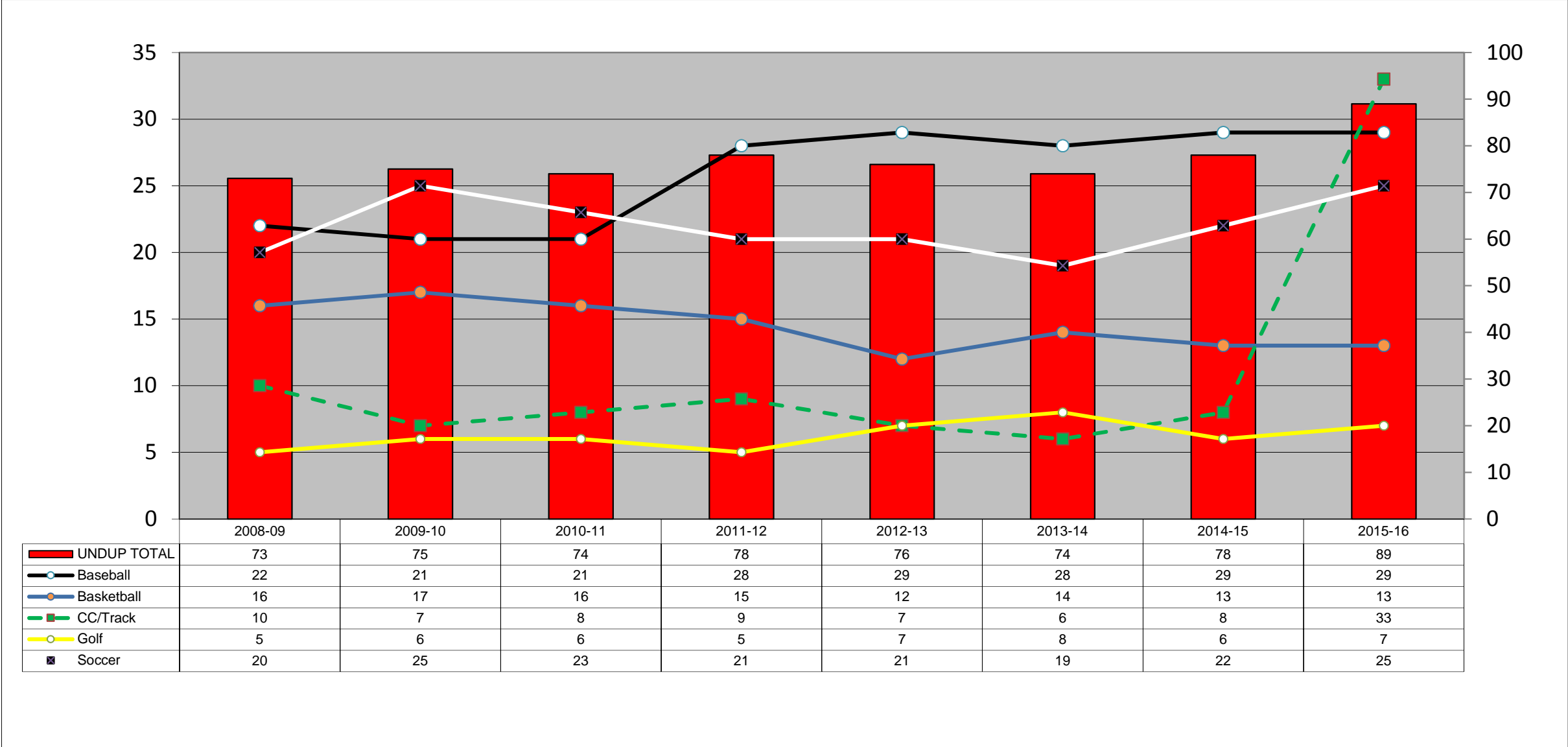

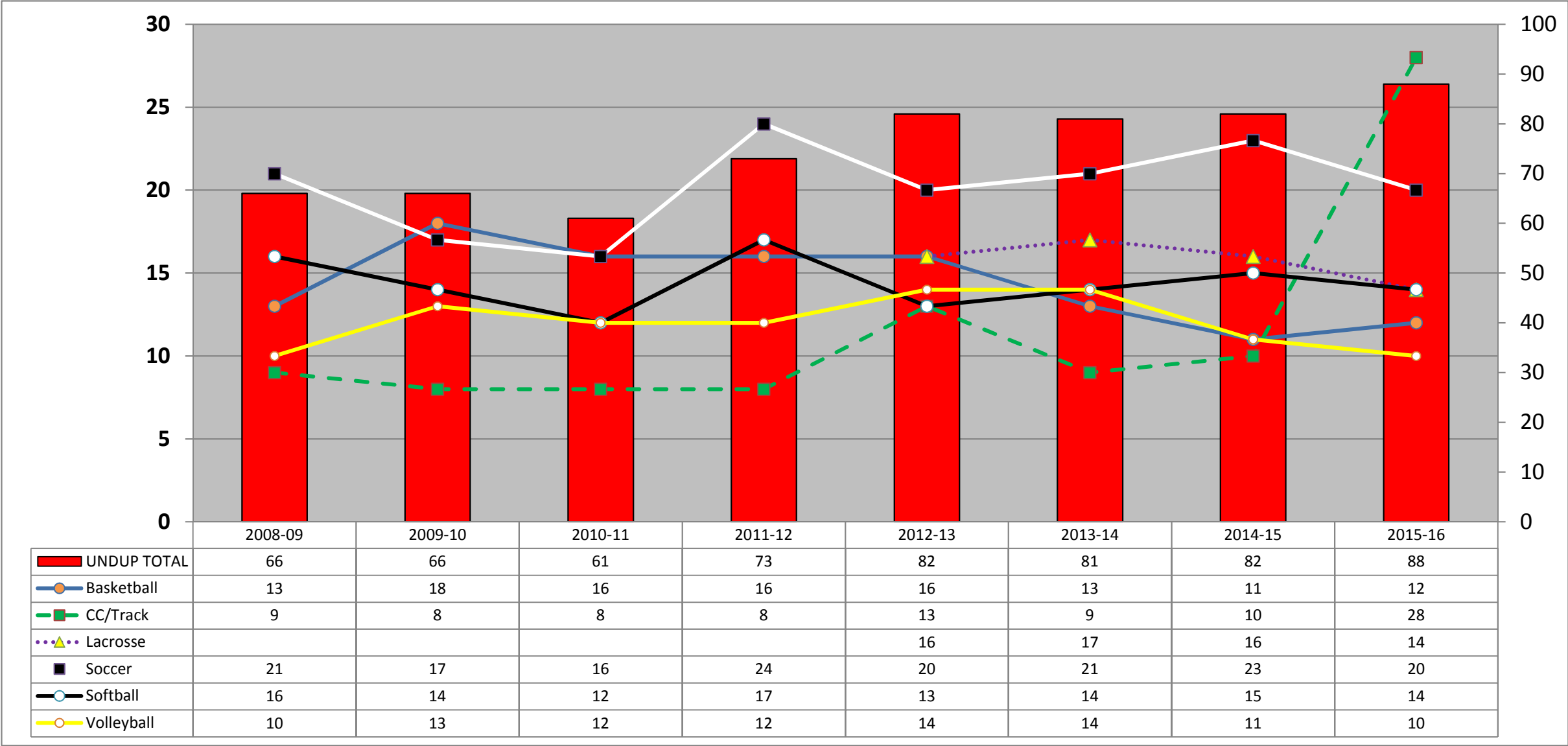

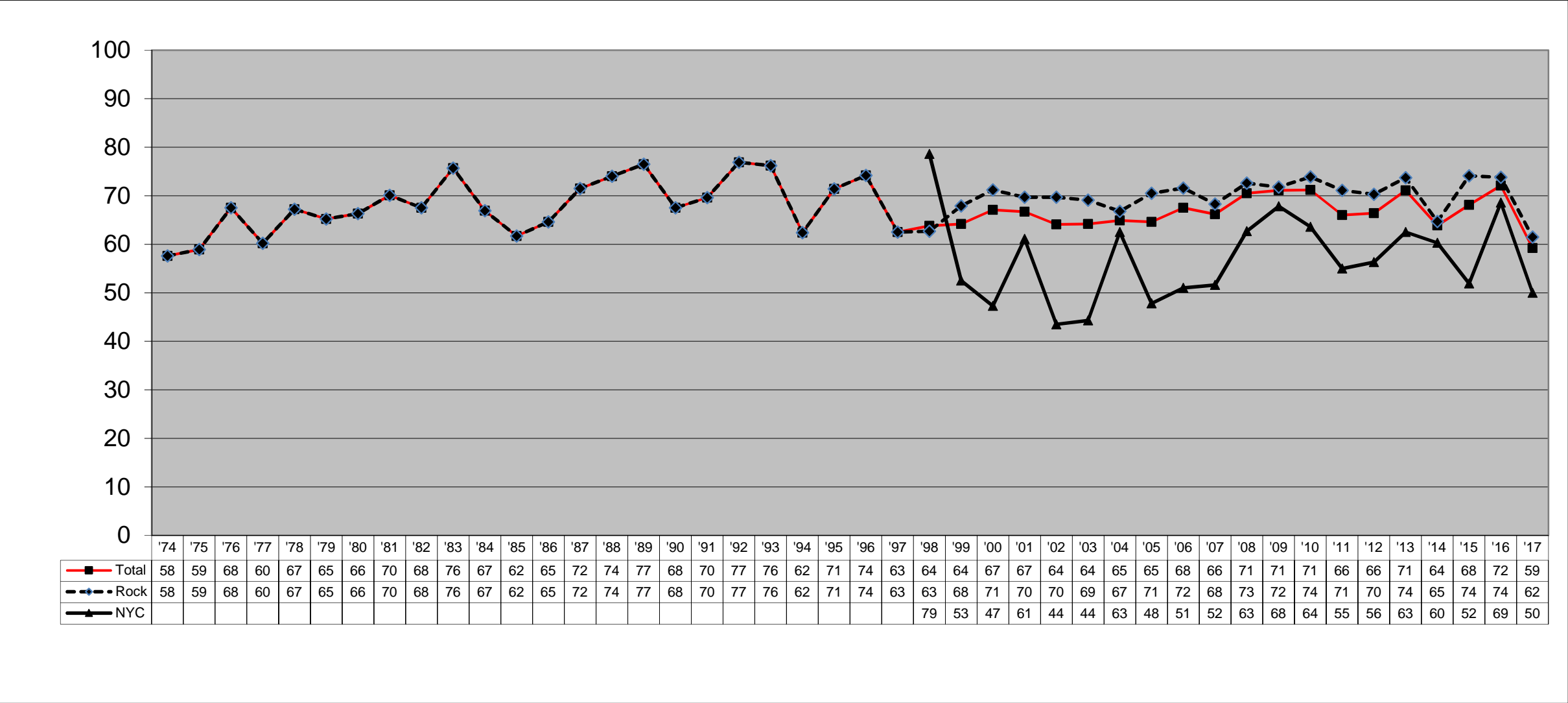

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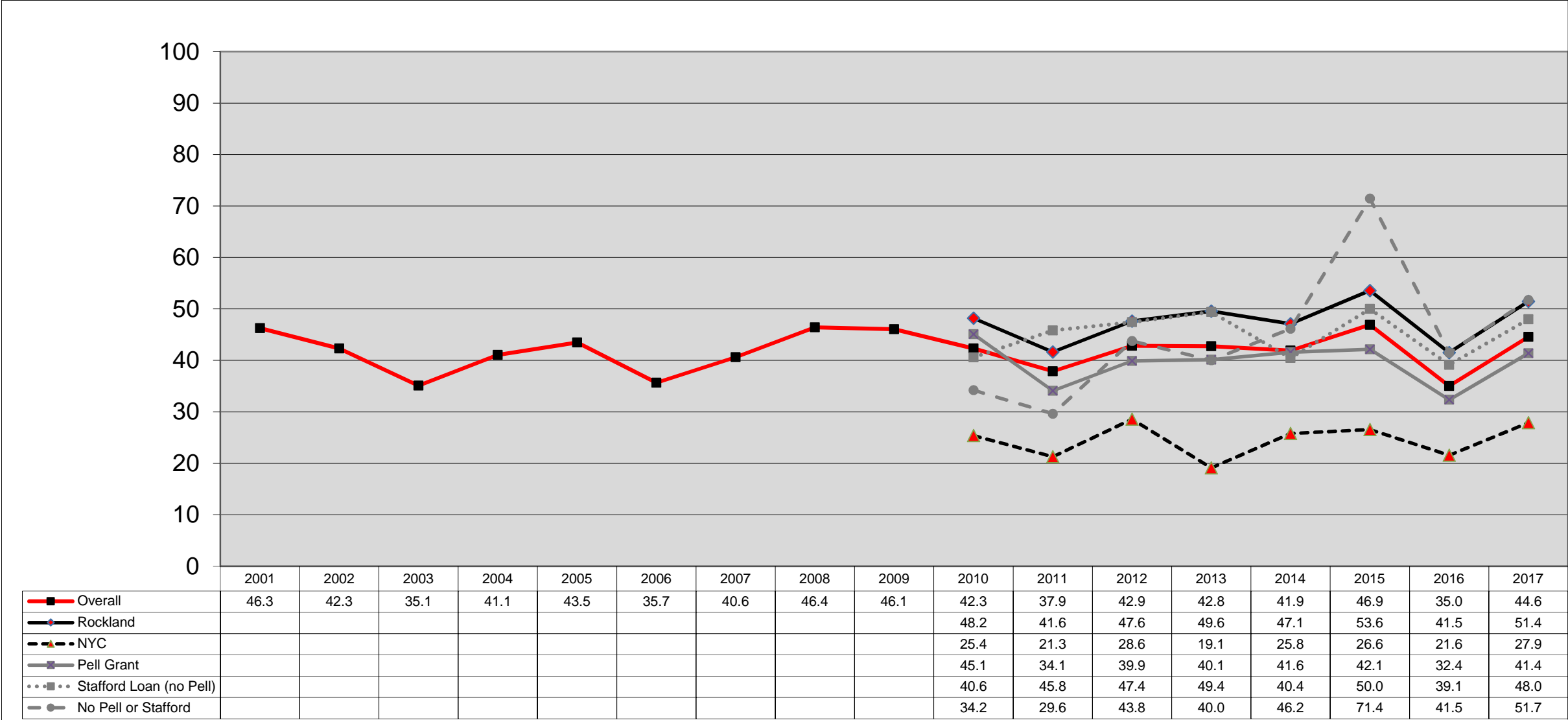

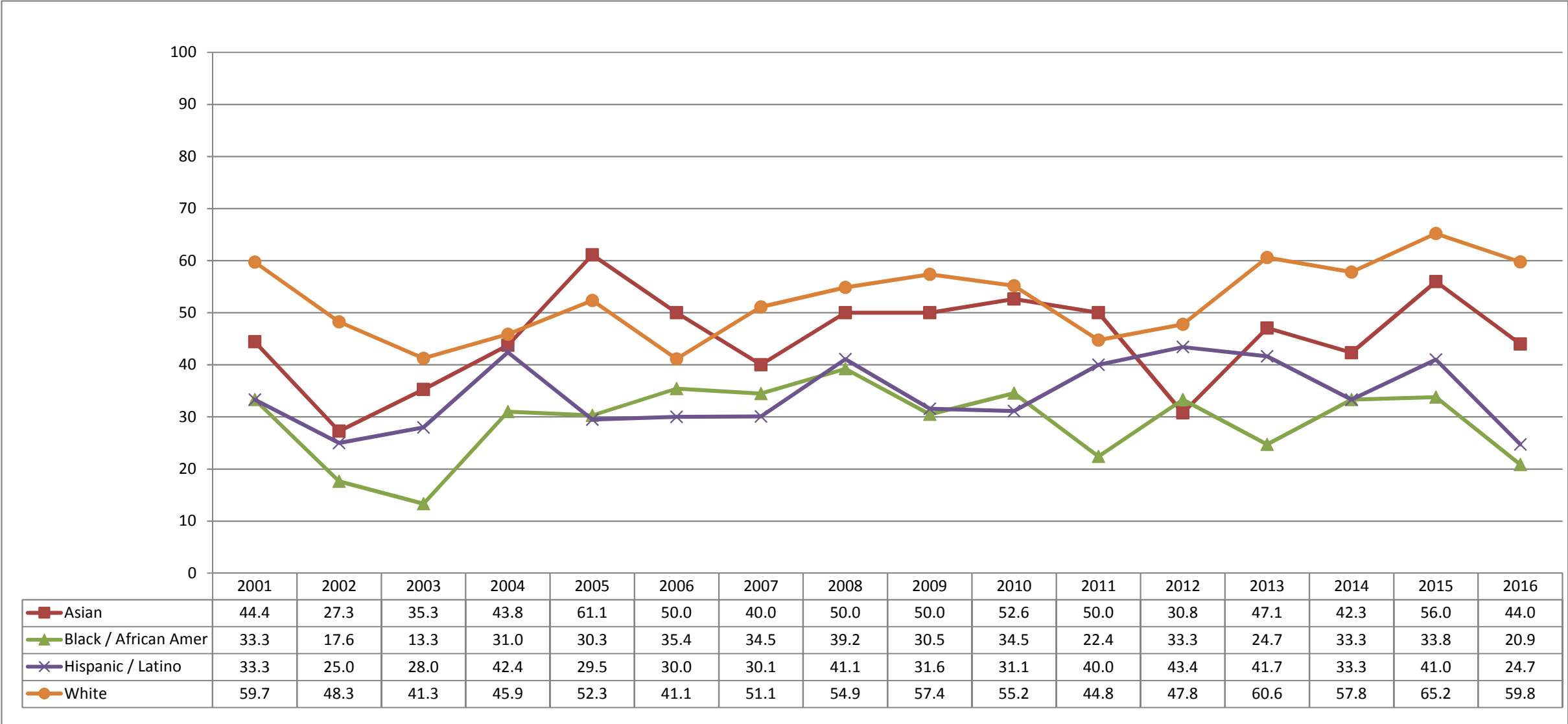

Graduation Rate by Race/Ethnicity

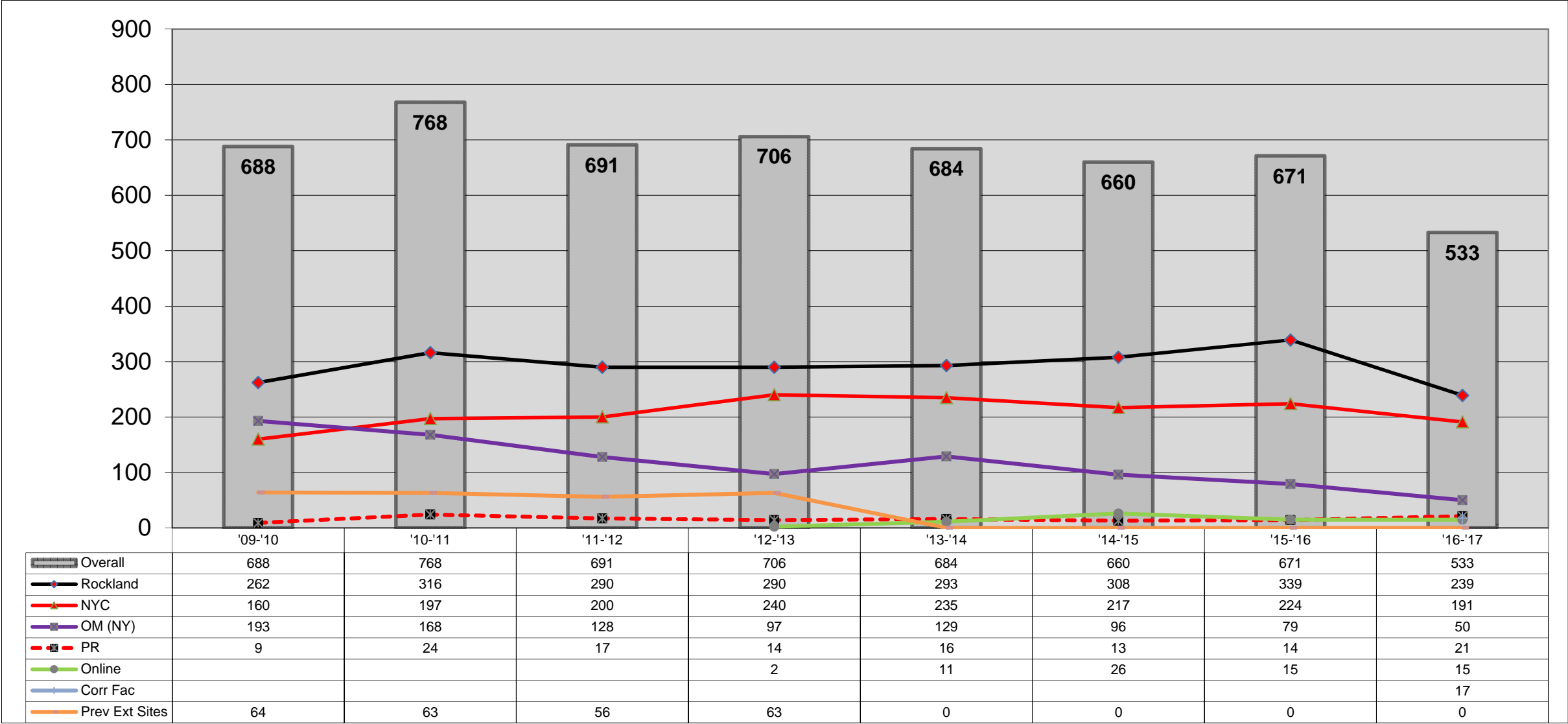
Full-Time, First-Time Freshmen (FTFTF)

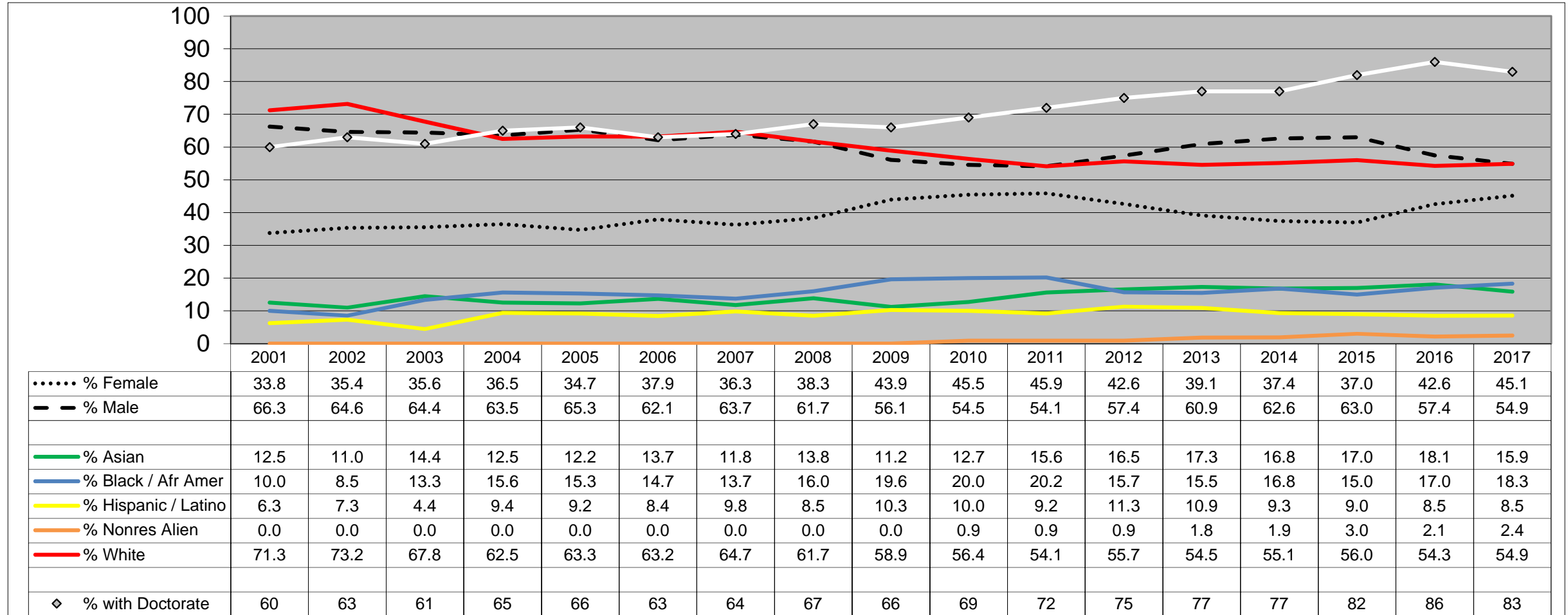

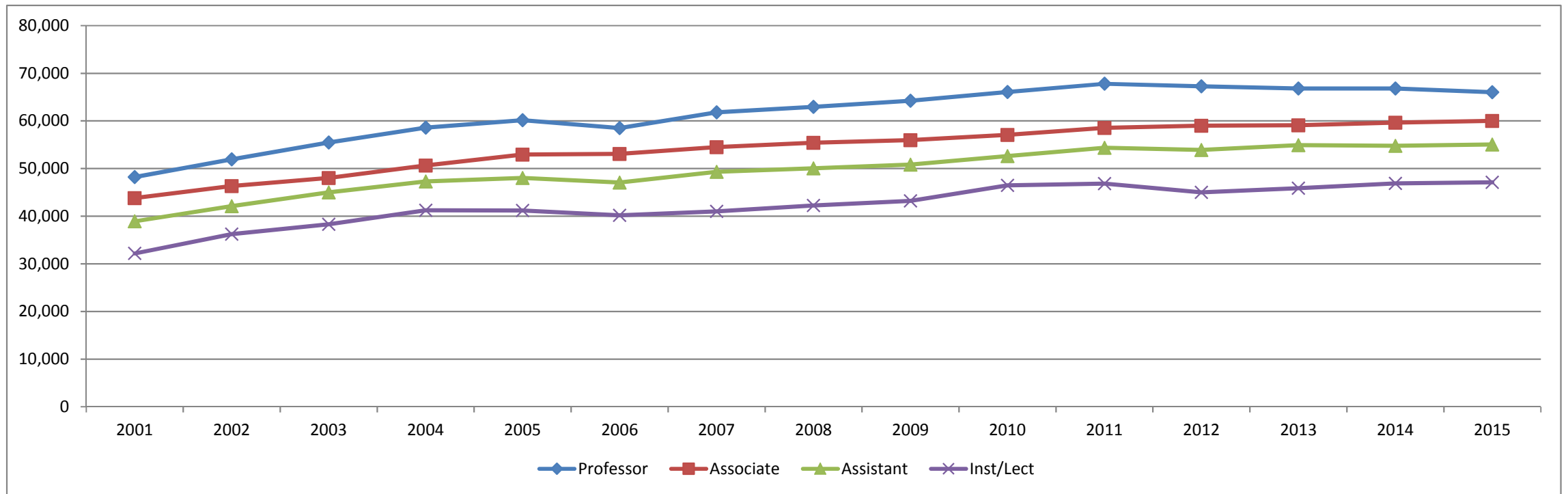

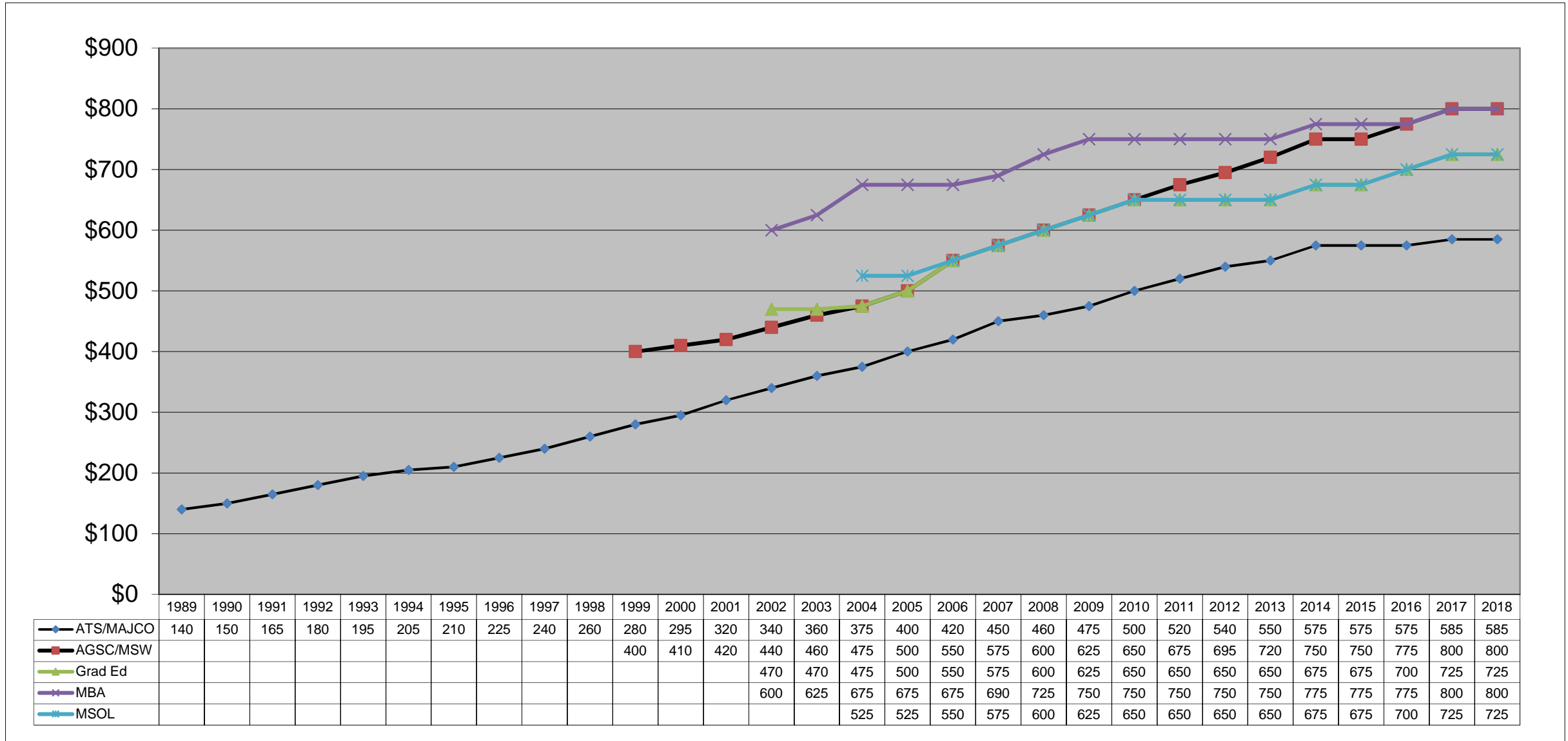

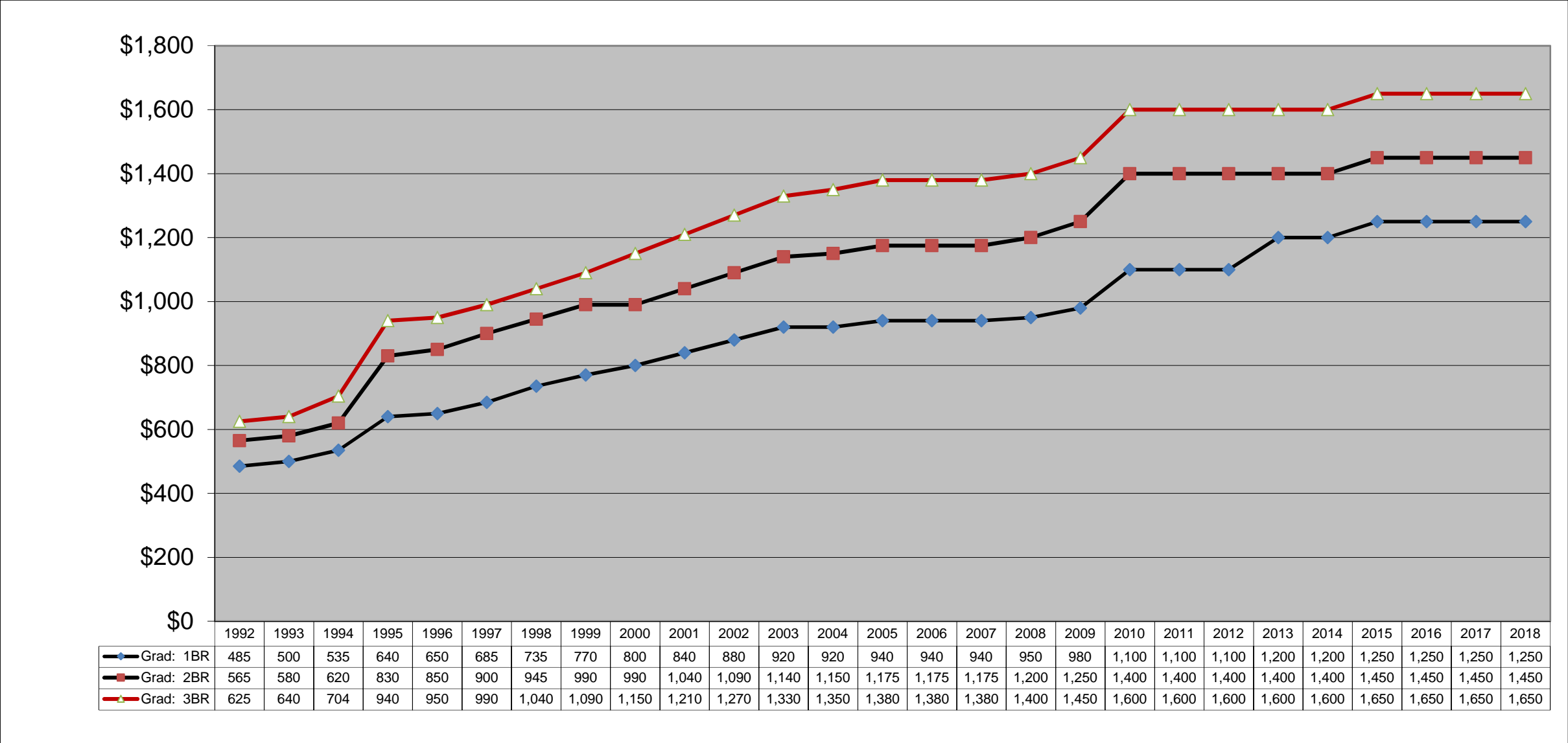

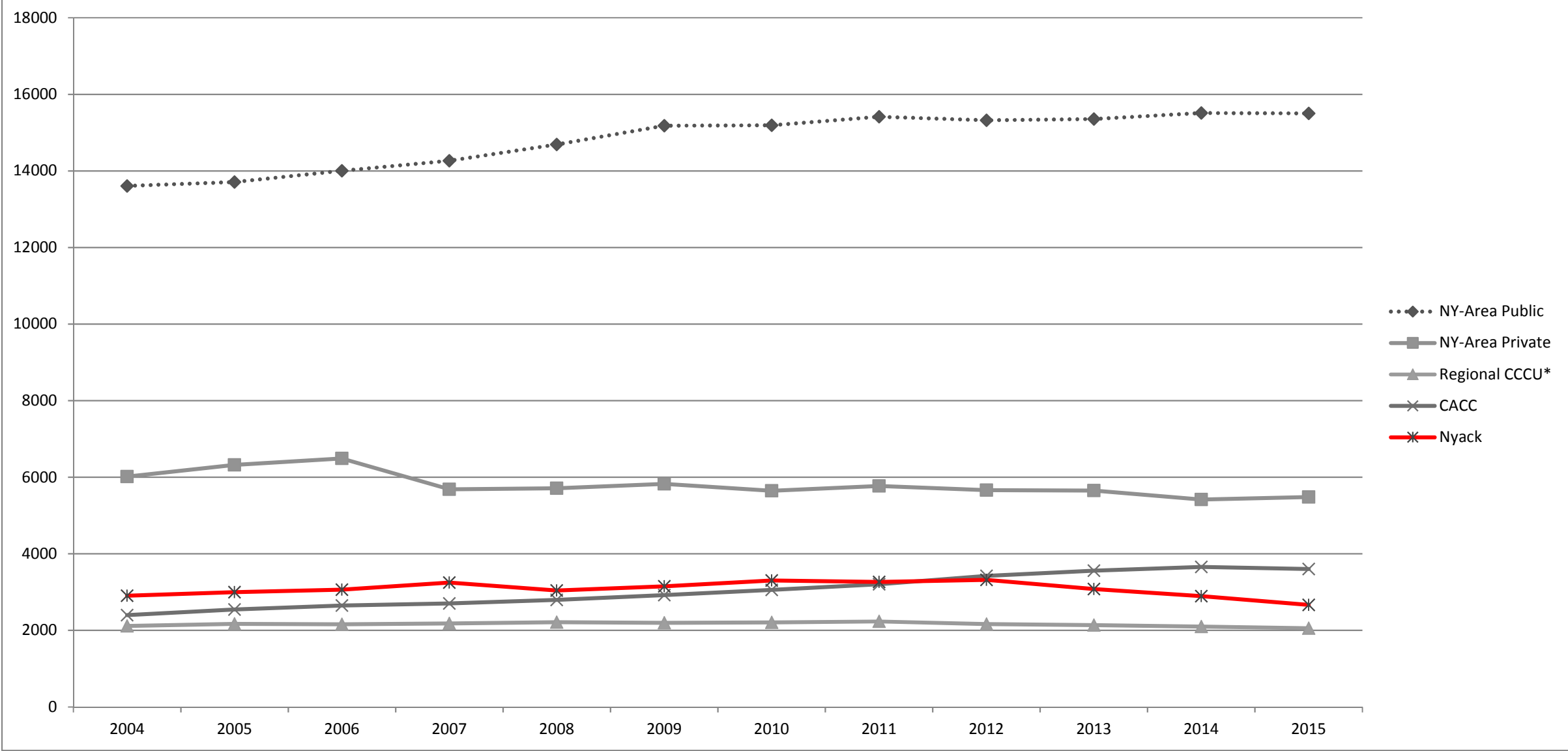

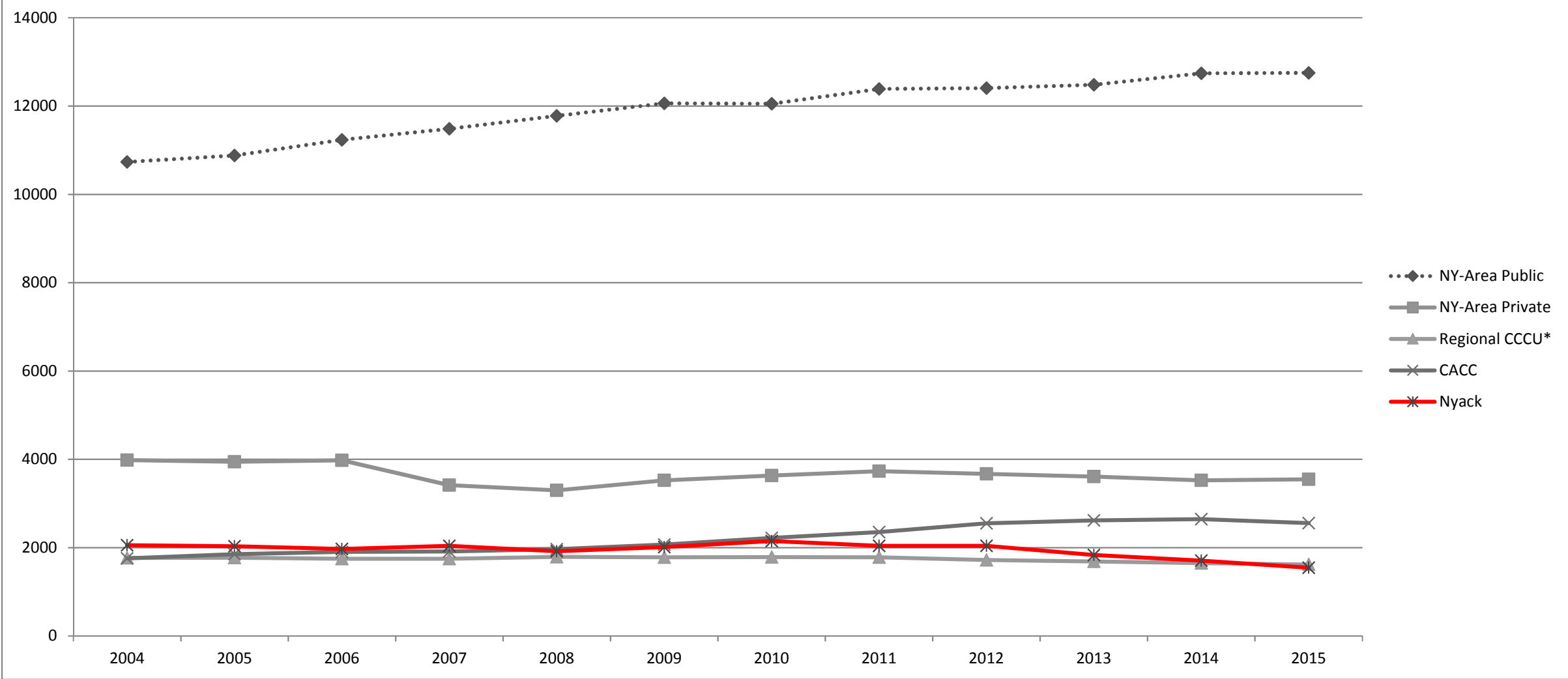

Total Fall Enrollment



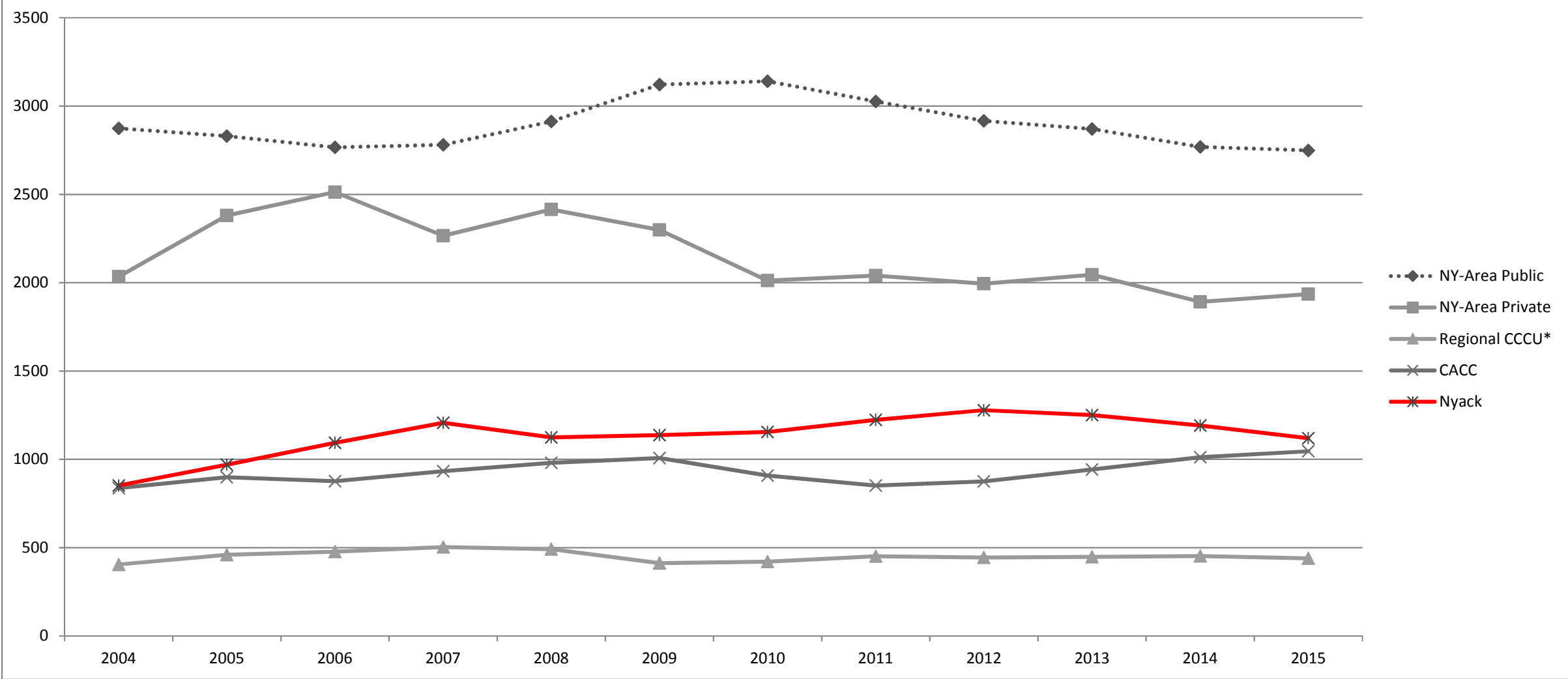

Undergraduate Fall Enrollment



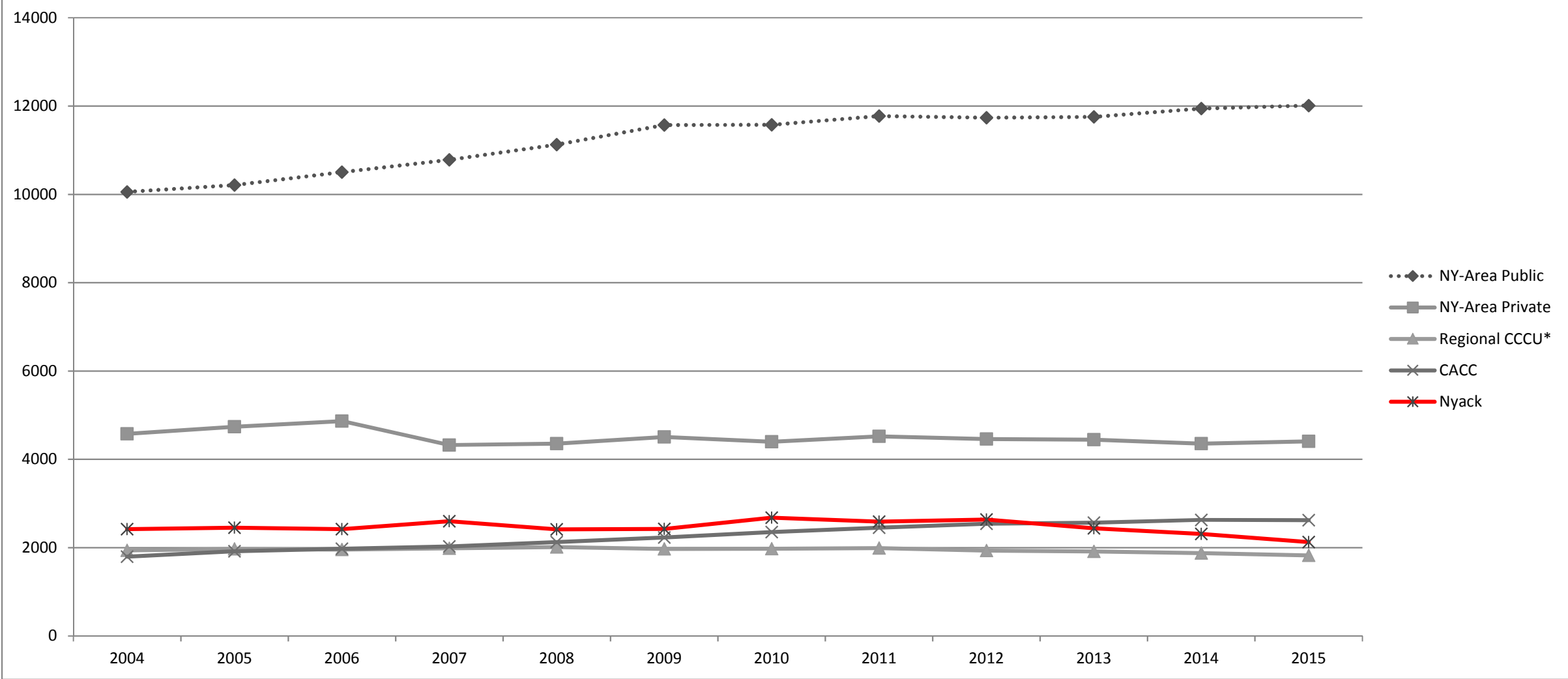

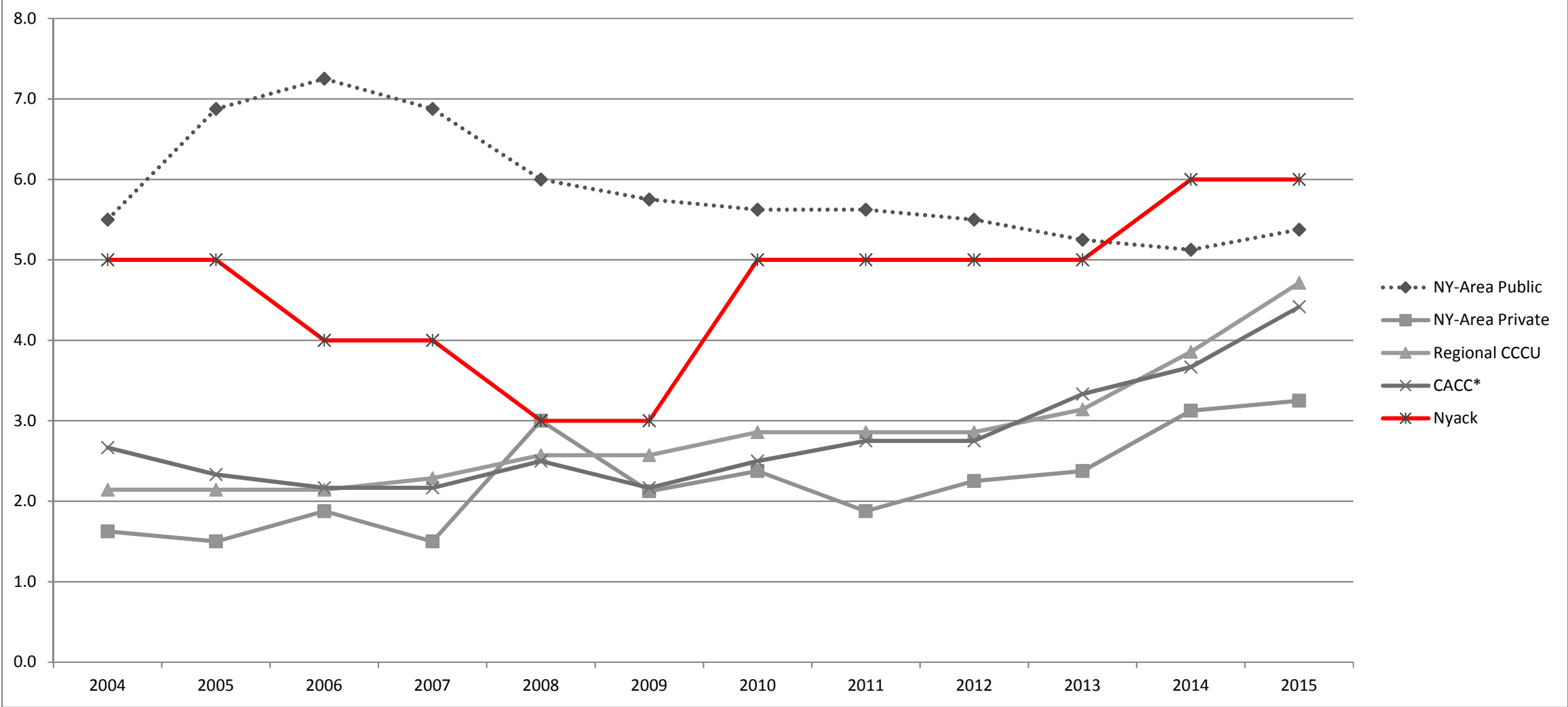
Total FTE (Fall)

As a percent of total enrollment

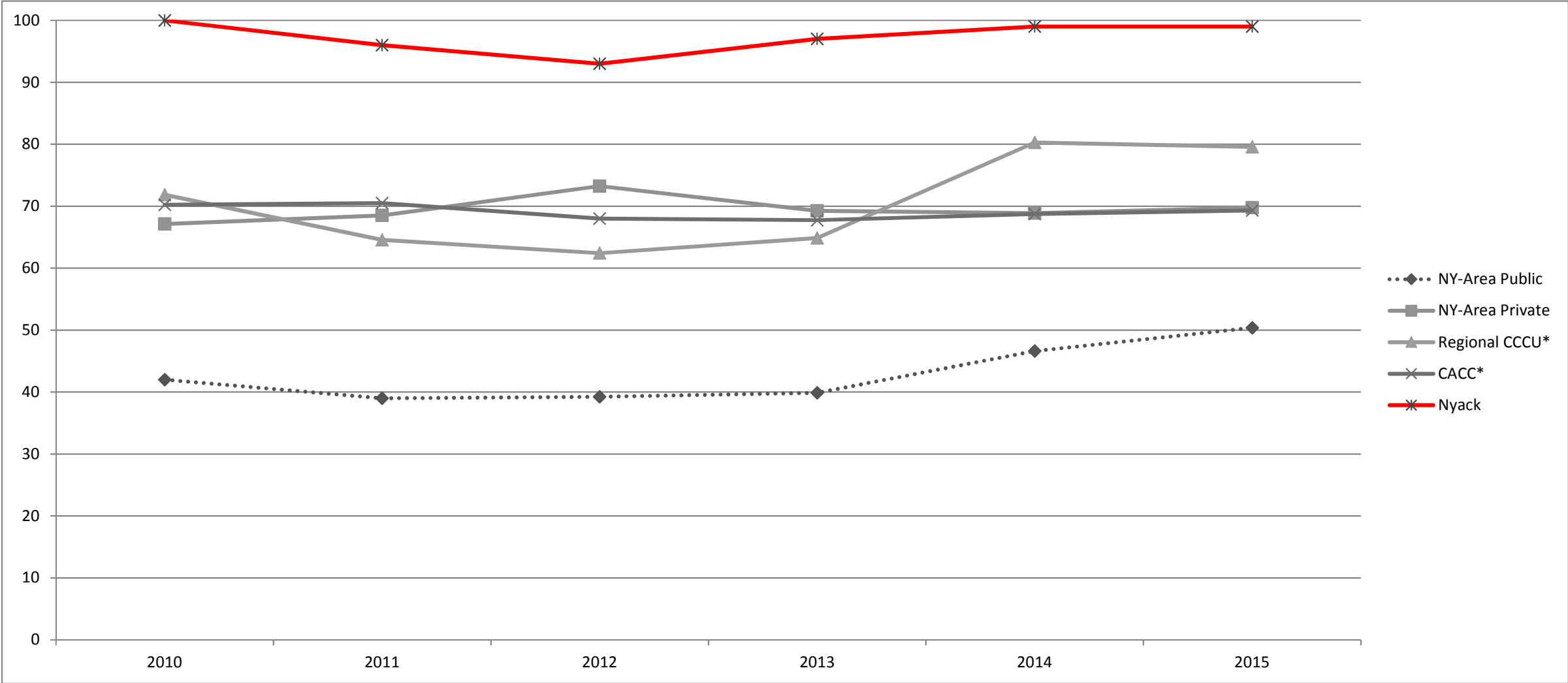

Admissions Rate



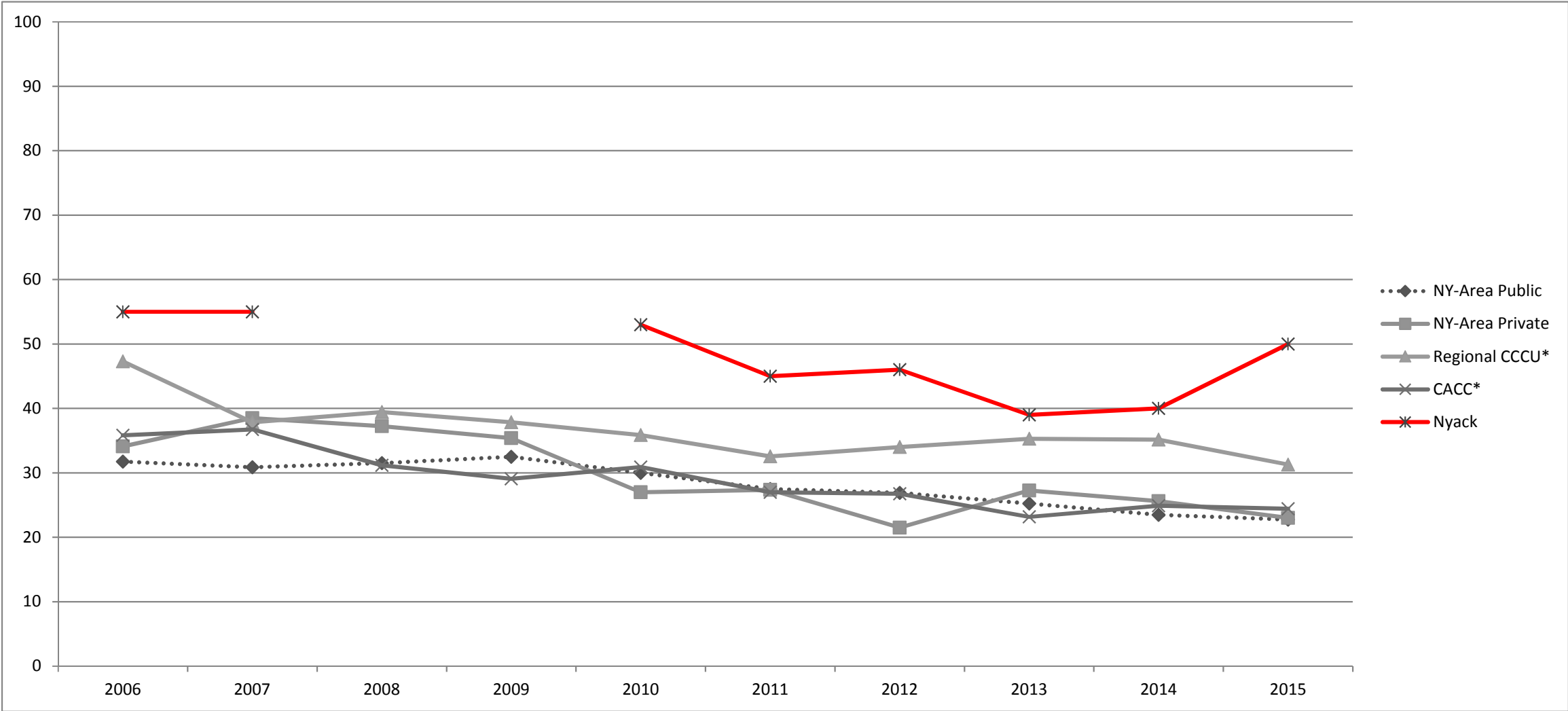

Admissions Yield Rate (% of admitted that enroll)



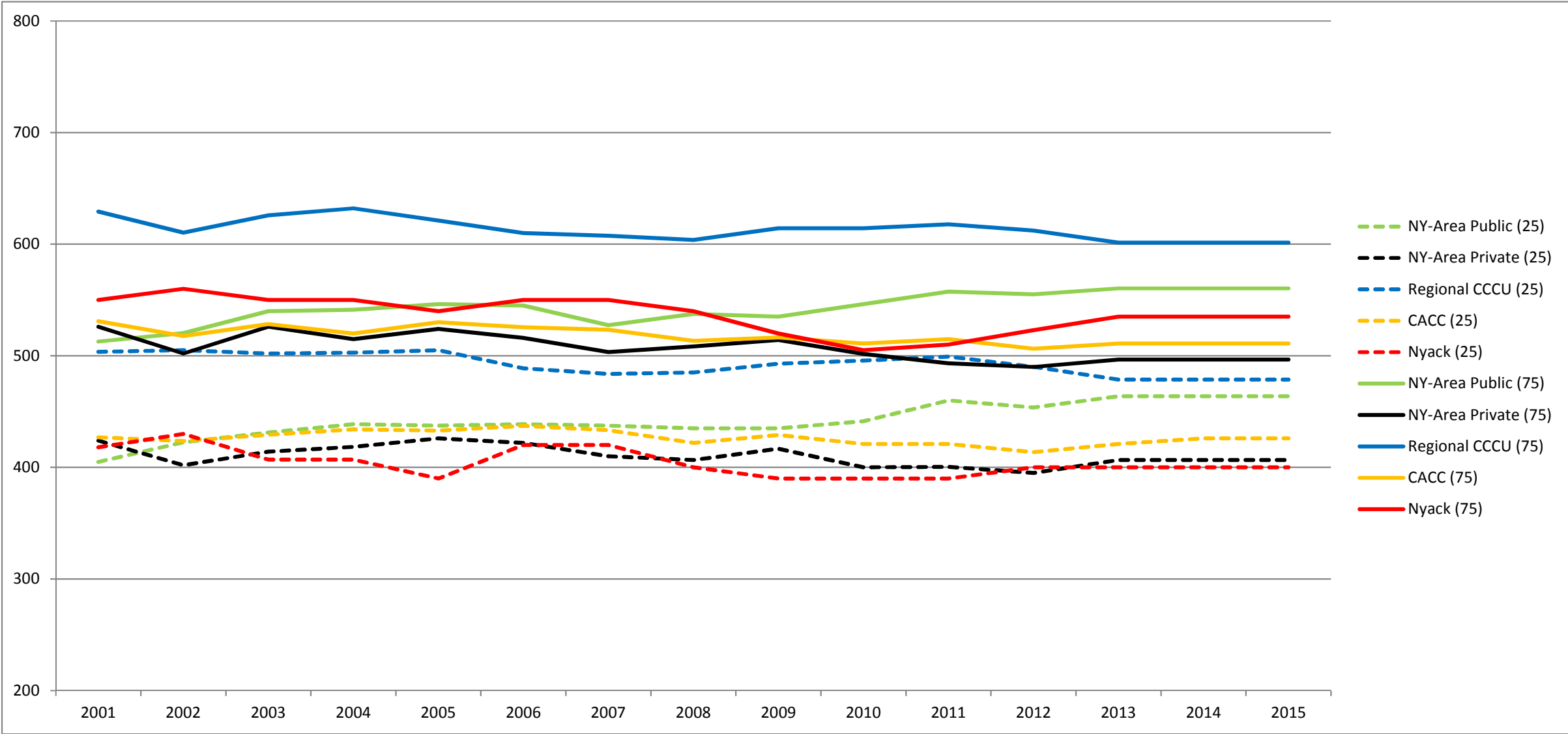

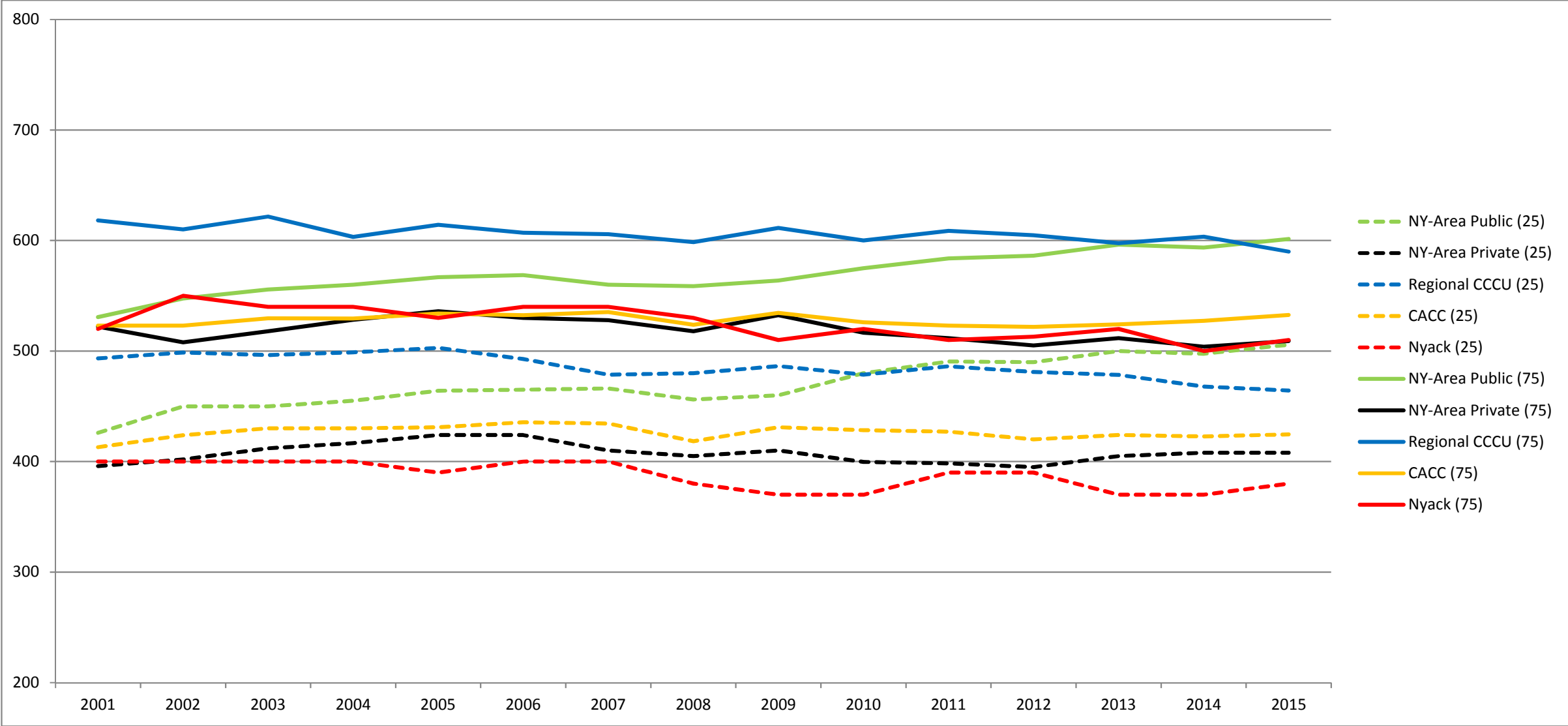

SAT Scores (Verbal) - 25th & 75th percentiles



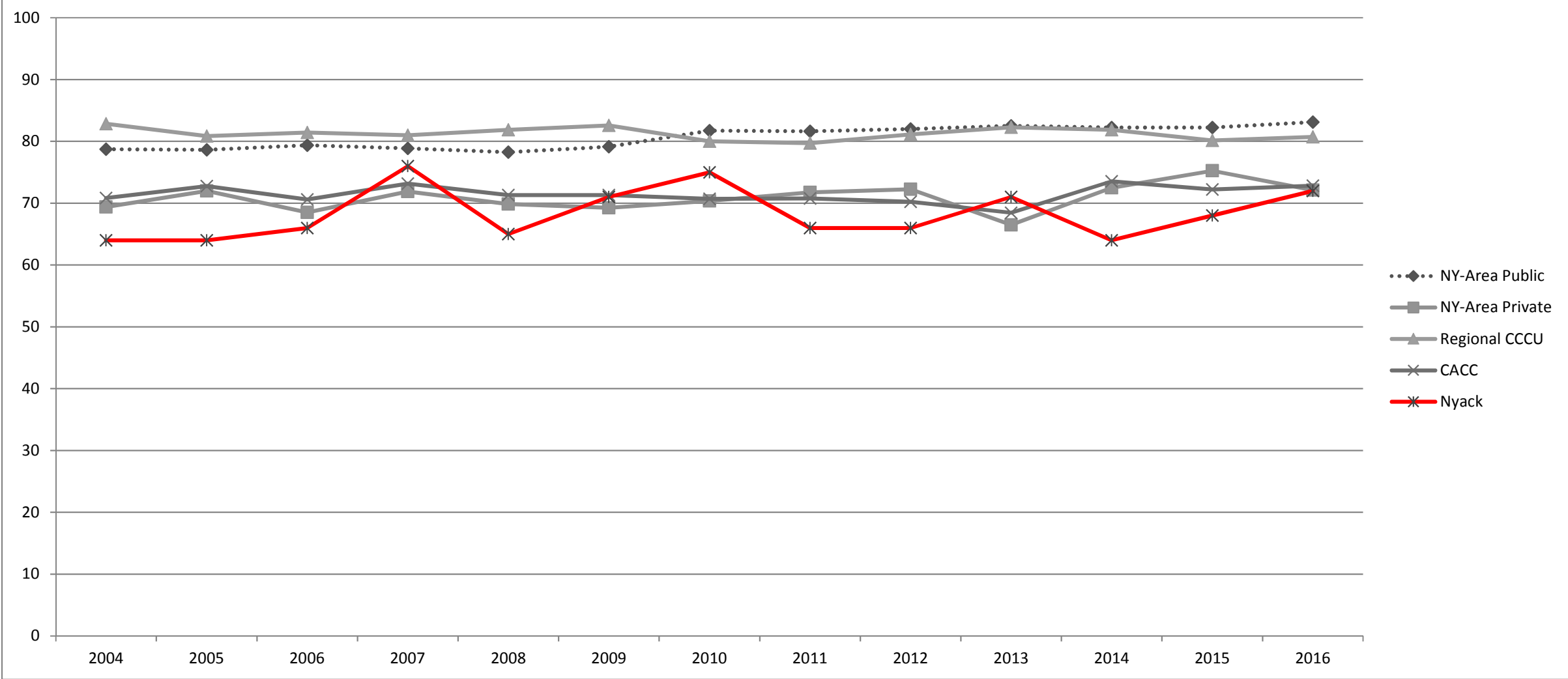

SAT Scores (Math) - 25th & 75th percentiles



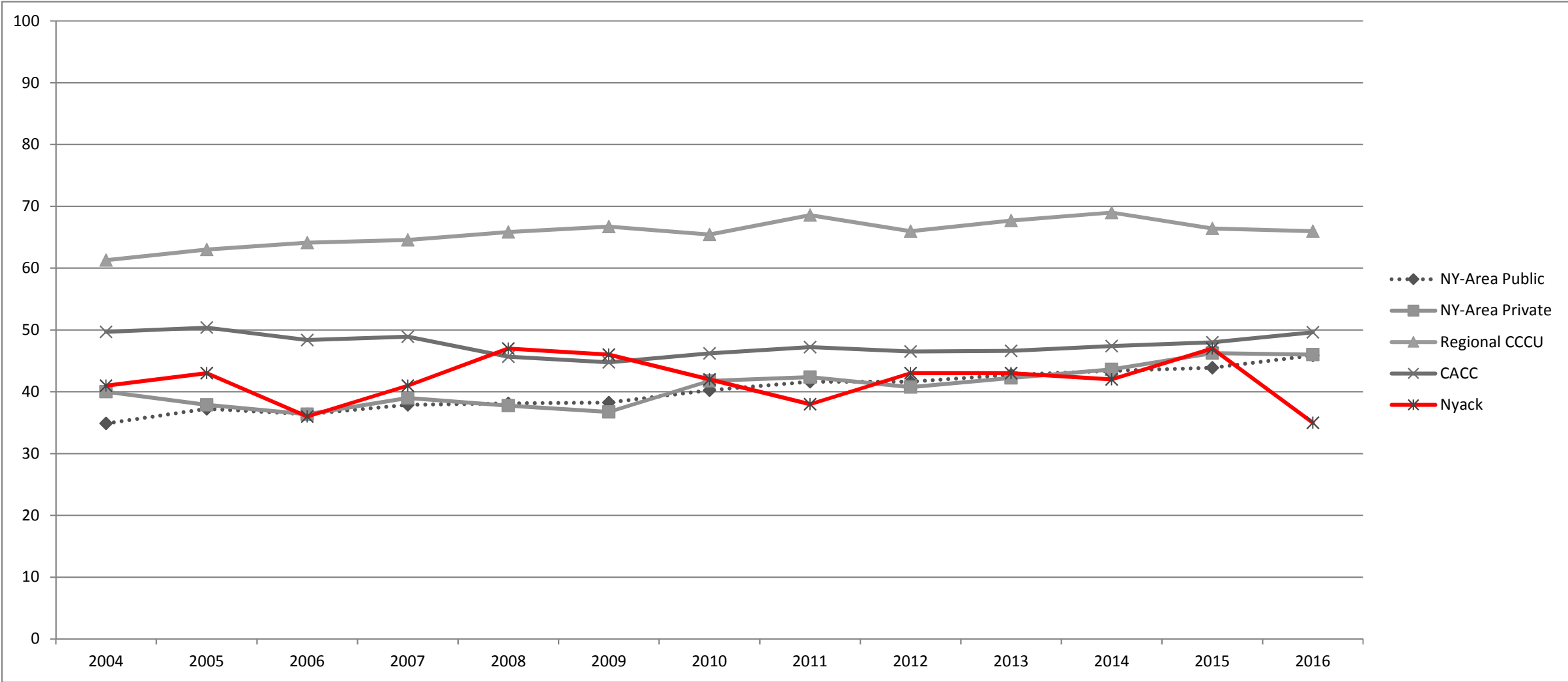

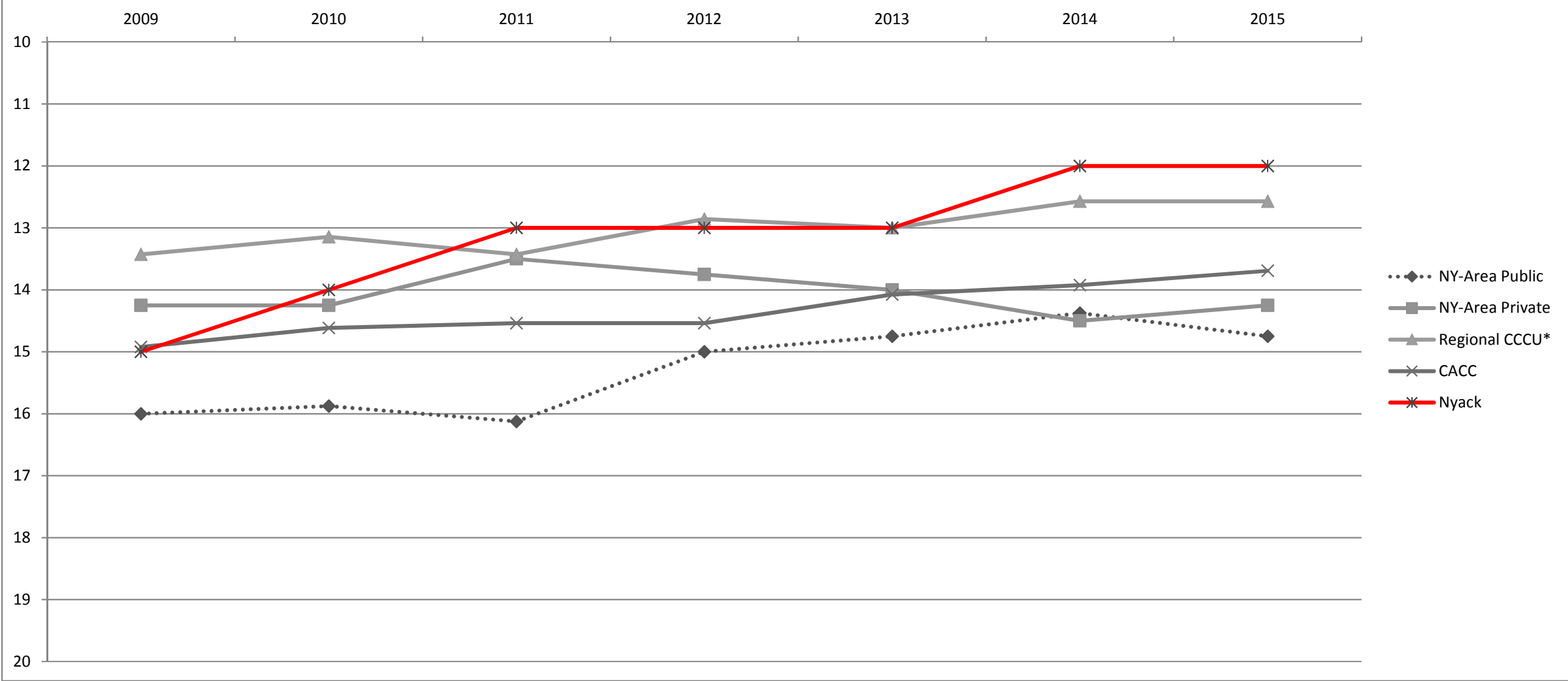
Graduation Rate (First-Time FT Degree-Seeking Cohort, Completers of 2 or 4-year Programs within 150%)

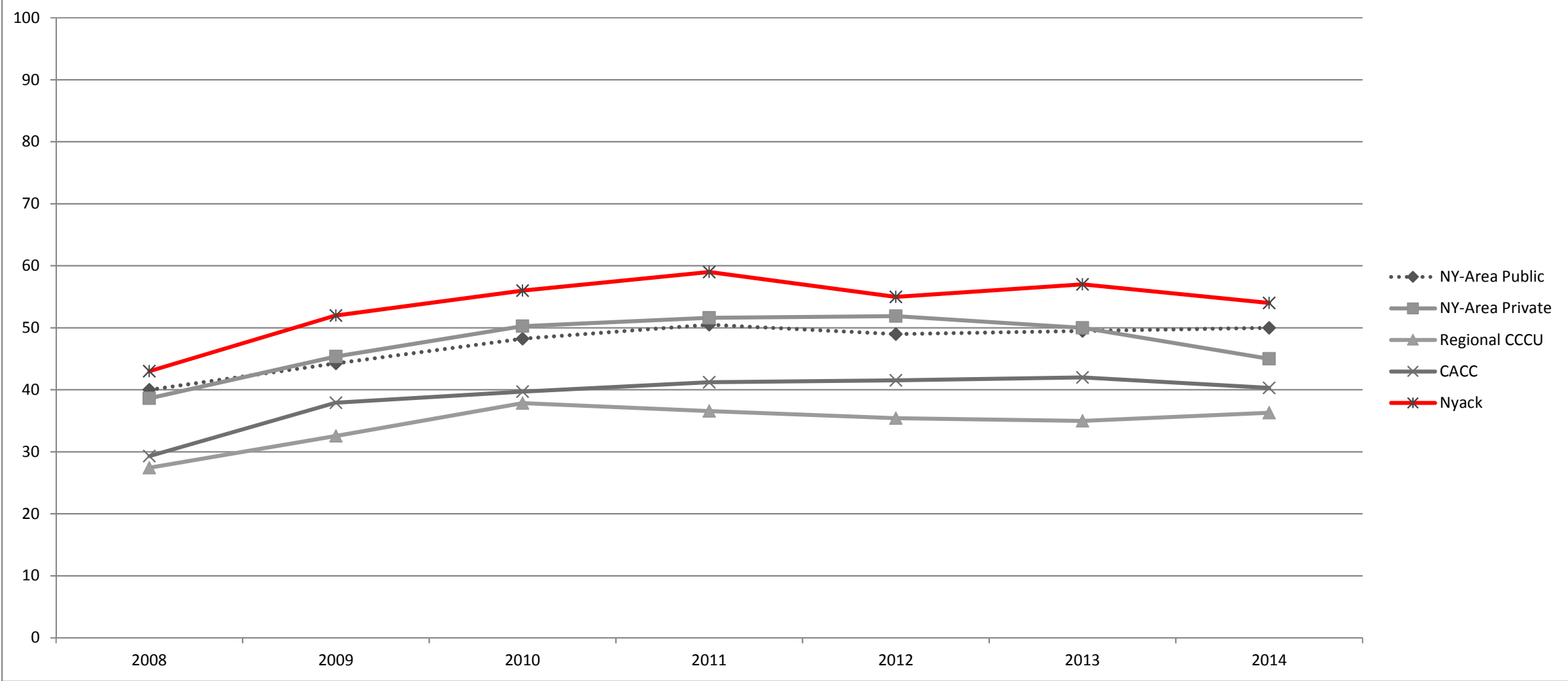
UG, Student FTE to Instructional Faculty FTE

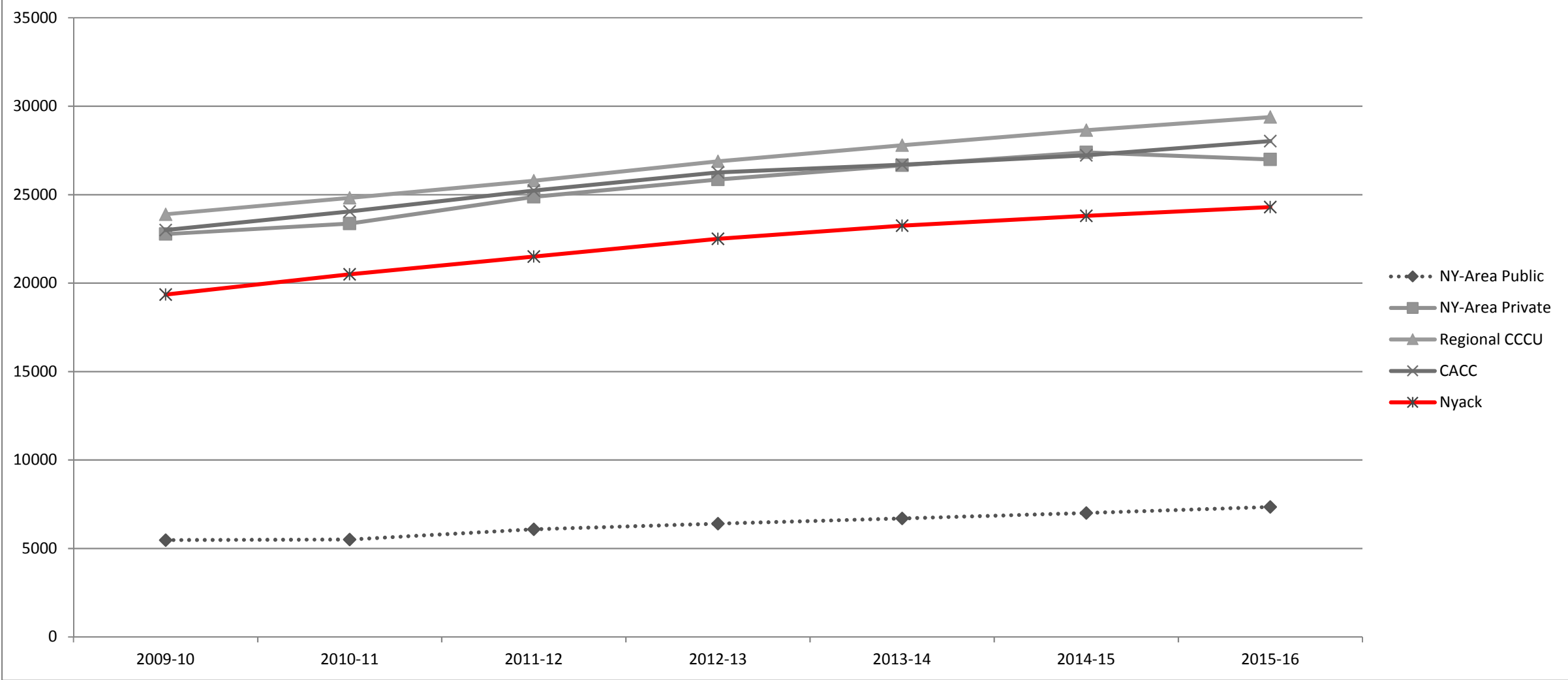
Percent of UG Students Receiving Pell Grants

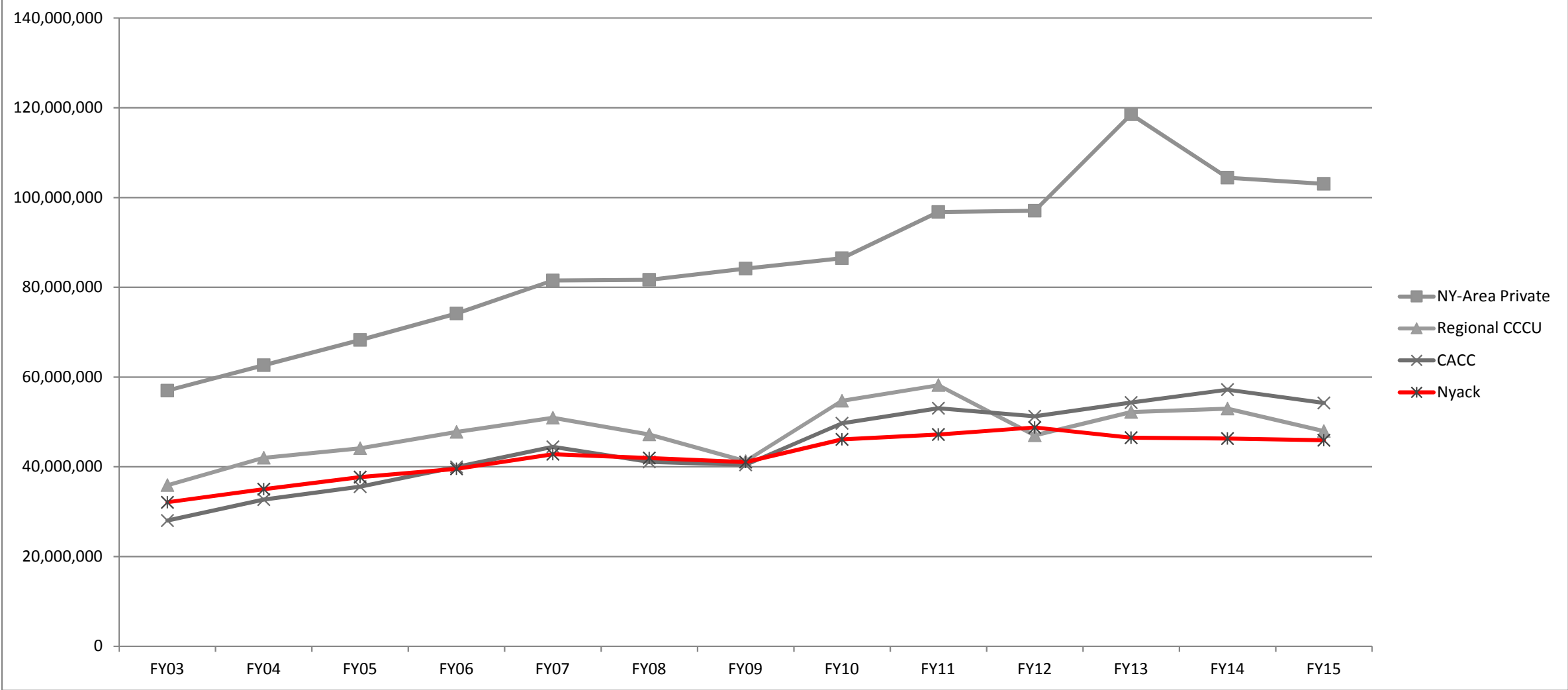

Revenue and Investment Return

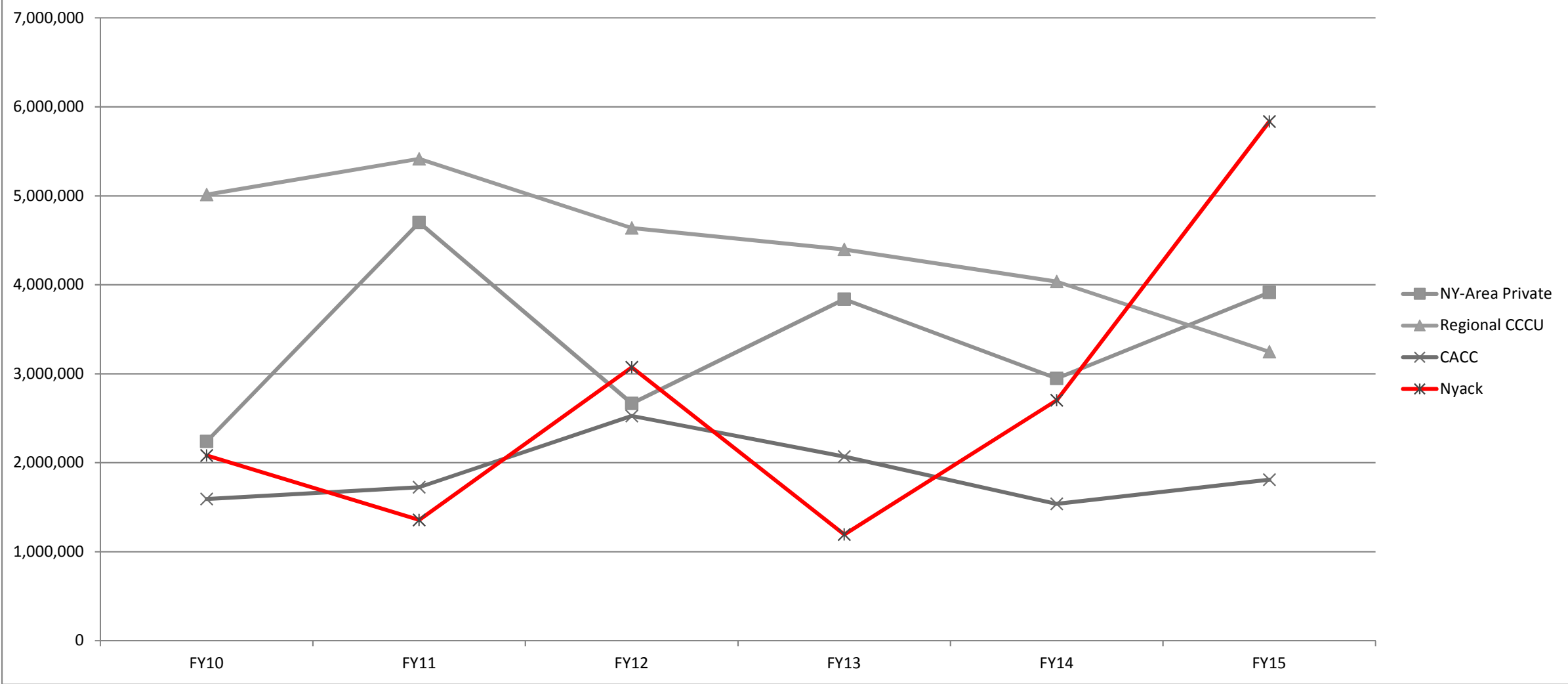

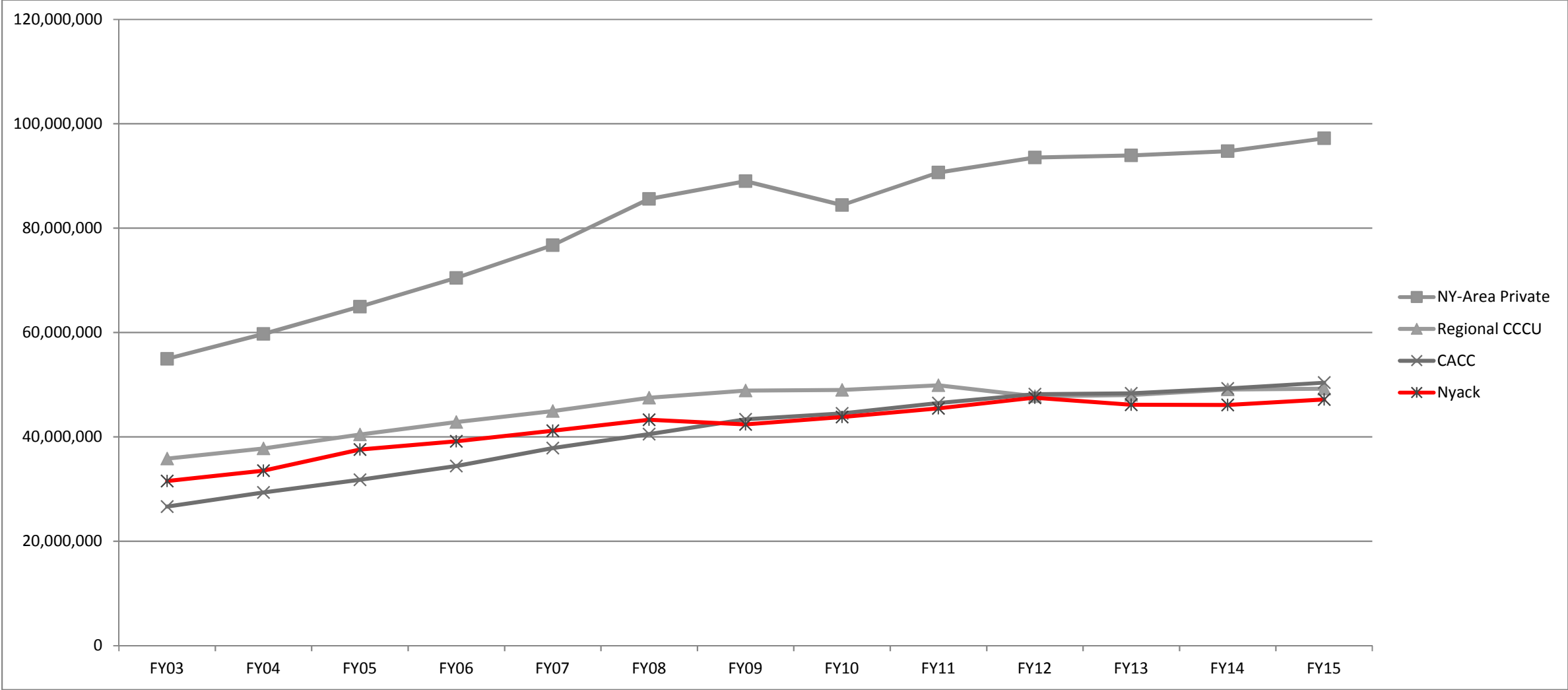

Total Expenses

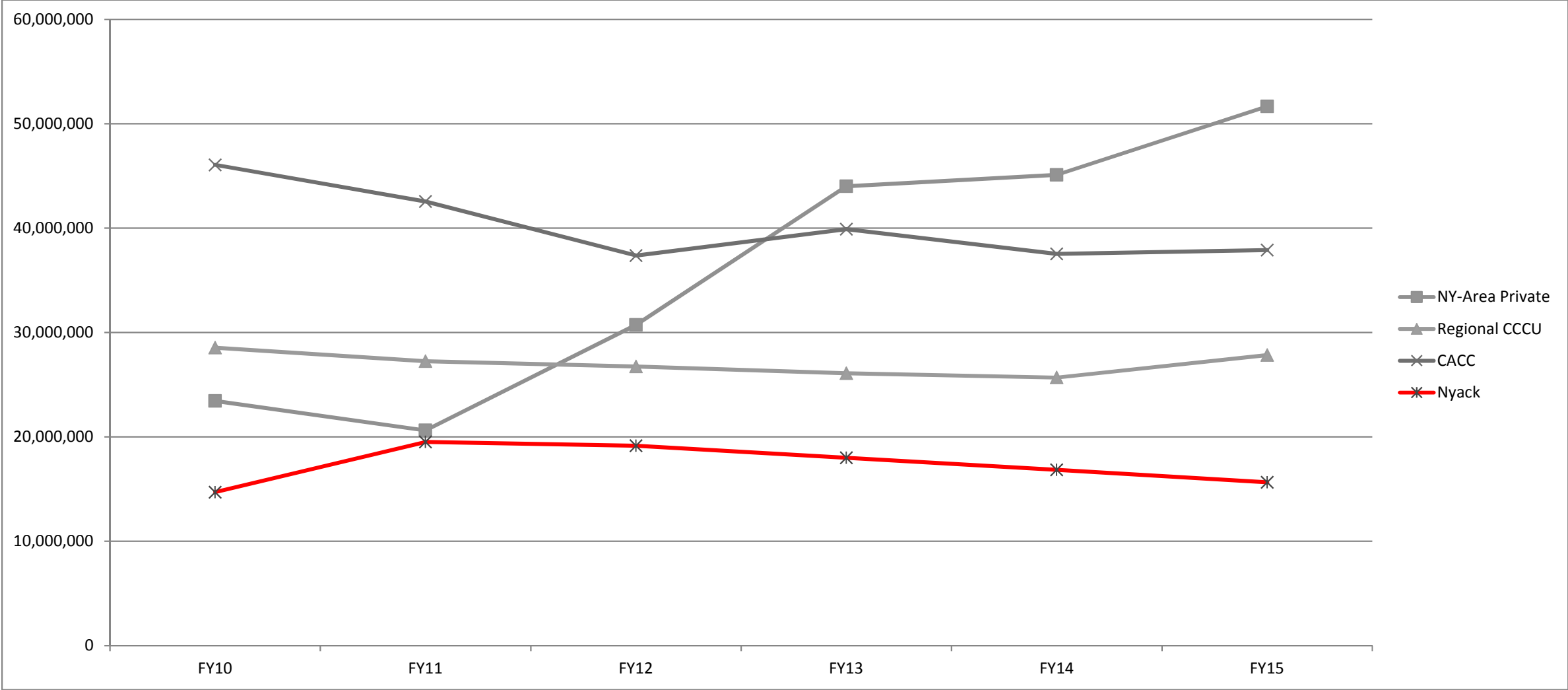

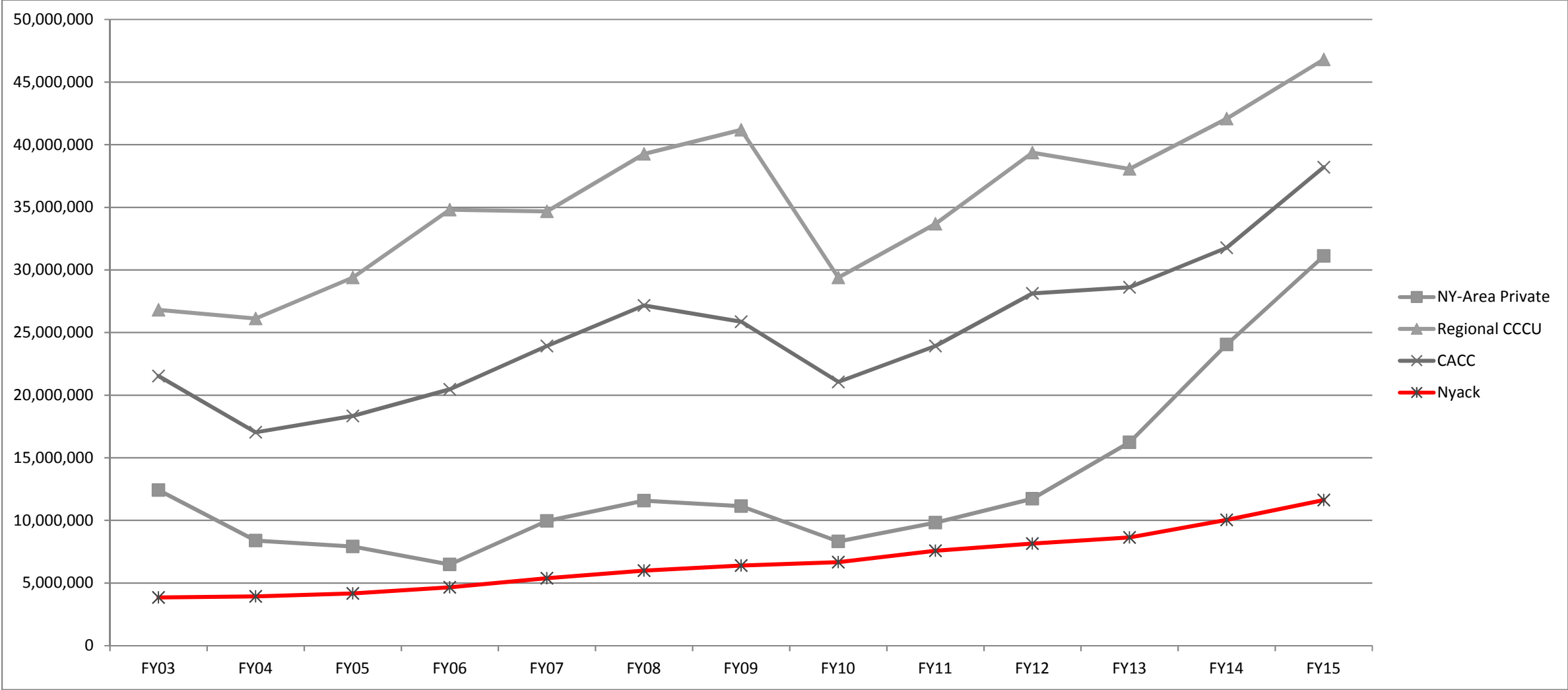
Debt (related to property, plant and equipment)
