

## **Creating and Submitting a Dance Video:**

Send us a 3-minute video via YouTube. Include in an email the URL (i.e. [www.youtube.com/WwiwrFb0tQU](http://www.youtube.com/WwiwrFb0tQU)).

You will NOT need to include the original audio from your footage. Please add audio using YouTube editing and searching for the music. Do not use music with copyright. Only use original music or lyrics to accompany your dance (YouTube also provides music options that do not have copyright). No song shall contain profanity or sexually-explicit or violent lyrics. For information on copyright issues, refer to the following link: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=gZ7XHZziBEc>.

All footage should be landscape (sideways), not portrait (up and down). Set your phone or video camera sit on a tripod for a landscape or wide shot. You should be centered in the frame throughout the video.

A studio space or public place, such as a church stage, will look more professional than your living room. Dancing outside (with good lighting) can work as well. Do not use footage of a previous live performance. The footage must be original and filmed for the Fine Print.

Attire for women: Liturgical wear

Attire for men: Crewneck t-shirt and pants

When you post the video, give your name as the dancer, the title of your video, and the title of the music in the description box.

With your video, send a paragraph of the creative process behind your dance in a Microsoft Word document using Times New Roman and 12 pt. font. Also, include your short biography and the style of dance.
